CERTIFICATE OF TRUST EXISTENCE AND AUTHORITY

OF THE

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- I, the undersigned, certify as follows:

 - (i) To accept and/or retain any property of any character whatsoever (including stock of any corporate trustee hereunder or of a parent or affiliate company) originally constituting the trust or subsequently added thereto, although not of a type, quality or diversification considered proper for trust investments.
 - (ii) To invest and reinvest the trust estate in bonds, stocks, mortgages, notes or other property of any kind, real or personal, suitable for the investment of trust funds.
 - (iii) To cause any securities or other property, real or personal, belonging to the trust to be held or registered in the TRUSTEE'S name or in the name of a nominee or in such other form as the TRUSTEE or

SUCCESSOR TRUSTEE, whichever the case shall be, deems best without disclosing the trust relationship.

- (iv) To vote in person or by general or limited proxy, or refrain from voting, any corporate securities for any purpose; to exercise or sell any subscription or conversion rights; to consent to and join in or oppose any voting trusts, reorganizations, consolidations, mergers, foreclosures and liquidations and in connection therewith to deposit securities and accept and hold other securities or property received therefor.
 - (v) To lease property in the trust estate for any period of time although commencing in the future or extending beyond the term of this trust.
 - (vi) To borrow money from any lender, including a trustee hereunder individually, extend or renew any existing indebtedness and mortgage or pledge any property in the trust.
- (vii) To sell at public or private sale, contract to sell, convey, exchange, transfer and otherwise deal with the trust property and any reinvestments thereof from time to time for such price and upon such terms as the TRUSTEE or SUCCESSOR TRUSTEE sees fit.
- (viii) To employ agents, attorneys and proxies and to delegate to them such powers as the TRUSTEE or SUCCESSOR TRUSTEE considers desirable.
 - (ix) To compromise, contest, prosecute or abandon claims in favor of or against the trust.
 - (x) To divide or distribute the trust estate in undivided interests or in kind, or partly in cash and partly in kind, and to sell any property in order to make division or distribution.
 - (xi) To deal with, purchase assets from, or make loans to, the fiduciary of any trust made by the GRANTOR or any member of his or her family or a trust or estate in which any beneficiary under this Agreement has an interest, though a trustee hereunder is such fiduciary, and to retain any property so purchased.
 - (xii) To establish out of income and credit to principal reasonable reserves for depreciation, obsolescence and depletion.

- (xiii) To transfer the situs of any trust property to any other jurisdiction as often as the TRUSTEE or SUCCESSOR TRUSTEE deems it advantageous to the trust, appointing a substitute trustee to act with respect thereto; and in connection therewith, to delegate to the substitute trustee any or all of the powers given to the TRUSTEE or SUCCESSOR TRUSTEE, which may elect to act as advisor to the substitute trustee and shall receive reasonable compensation for so acting; and to remove any acting substitute trustee and appoint another, or reappoint itself, at will.
