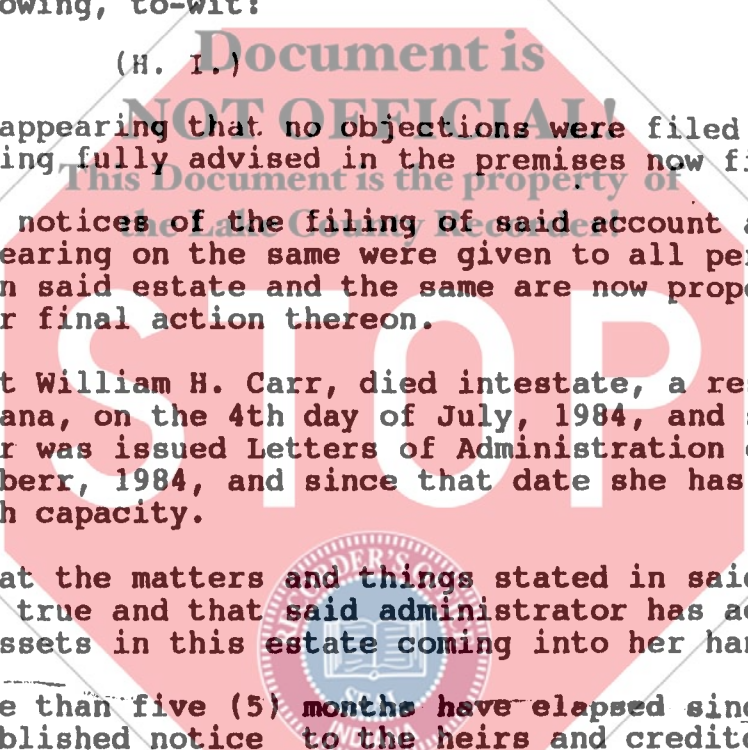
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Dec, This cause having been set for hearing this 3rd day of 1993, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account and for authority to distribute estate filed by Shirley L. Perkins, administratrix of the estate of William H. Carr, Deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the court for final action thereon.
2. That William H. Carr, died intestate, a resident of Lake County, Indiana, on the 4th day of July, 1984, and said administrator was issued Letters of Administration on the 2nd day of November, 1984, and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.
- 3., That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said administrator has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.
4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; no claim(s) was filed against said estate; neither said decedent nor his administrator were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.
5. That the decedent died leaving the following heirs at law pursuant to the provisions of Indiana Code, I. C. 29-1-2-1, married, leaving two children, Shirley L. Perkins and Floretta Beverly, adults, and left no other child or children, nor descendants of any predeceased child or children,

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other than those enumerated above.

6. That the decedent owned no real estate other than a piece of real estate located at 4740 Alexander Street, East Chicago, Indiana, legally described as: Lot 29, Blk. 11, Subdivision of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 37 North, Range 9, West of the 2nd P.M., as shown in Plat Book 2, page 25, in the Office of the REcorder of Lake County, Indiana; said real estate upon the death of the decedent vested by the laws of intestacy in Shirley L. Perkins, and Floretta Beverly, adult children, 1/2 interest each, as tenants in common, and a copy of this decree showing the vesting of said real estate should be recorded in the office of the Lake County Recorder.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Administratrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That no assets came into the hands of the administratrix for distribution by said administratrix except for the real estate set forth in the final accounting, which is hereby in all things approved.


3. That pursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit: Lot 29, Blk. 11, Subdivision of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 37 North, Range 9, West of the 2nd P.M., as shown in Plat Book 2, page 25, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana;

is hereby vested in SHIRLEY L. PERKINS and FLORETTA BEVERLY, as tenants in common.

And that said administratrix is hereby directed to procure and record in the office of the REcorder of Lake County, being the county in which said real estate is located, a certified copy of this Final Decree.

4. ~~Said administratrix is hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility as administratrix of the estate of William H. Carr, deceased.~~
