final account, petition to settle and allow account and for authority  
to distribute estate filed by Edward Jarosz, as executor of the

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the  
Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of  
the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said  
estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action  
thereon.

2. That Edwin Rusin, died testate, a resident of the County of  
Lake, State of Indiana, on the 11 day of January, 1993, and his Last  
Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on  
the 5 day February, 1992 and this Court appointed said Edward Jarosz  
as executor of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said  
executor was issued Letters of Testamentary on the 5 day of February,  
1993, to him and since that date he has continued to serve in such  
capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and  
petition are true and that said executor has accounted for all of the  
assets in said estate coming into his hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the  
first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said  
decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and  
discharged; neither said decedent nor his executor were employers of  
labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana  
Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and  
gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been  
paid.

5. The following persons are the sole legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament: Irene Orzel and Rose Orzel equally, and that all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and expenses of administration has been distributed to the above named persons.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 5031 Baring, East Chicago, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot 30, Block 3, in a Subdivision of the East 1510.2 feet of the North 1320 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 37 North, Range 9 West of the Second Principal Meridian, except the East 201 feet thereof, in the City of East Chicago, as shown in Plat Book 2, page 16, in Lake County, Indiana.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said executor's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting, as prescribed under the Last Will Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot 30, Block 3, in a Subdivision of the East 1510.2 feet of the North 1320 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 37 North, Range 9 West of the Second Principal Meridian, except the East 201 feet thereof, in the City of East Chicago, as shown in Plat Book 2, page 16, in Lake County, Indiana.

is hereby vested in Rose Orzel and Irene Orzel as tenants in common pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

And that said executor is hereby directed to procure and record in the office of the Recorder of Lake County, being the county in which said real estate is located, a certified copy of this Final Decree.

4. Said executor having made distribution of all assets and property and having attached affidavit in lieu of vouchers evidencing said distribution to said legatees and devisees, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

5. Said executor is hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility along with his surety as said executor of the estate of Edwin Rusin. All of which is ordered this 25th day of January, 1993.
