MORITGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED APRIL 11, 1994, between JOAN DYKSTRA, whose address is 412 - 414TH SCHERERVILLE, IN: 46375 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and CENTIER BANK, whose address is 1500 119th Street, Whiting, IN 46394 (referred to below as "Lender");

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right tille, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock-in utilities with-ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals; oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in LAKE County, State of Indiana (the "Real Property"):

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest In the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal, beneficial or equitable; whether voluntary, or involuntary, whether by outlingth sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, teasehold interest within a termigreater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interestin or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property; or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done-on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of allitiens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the tien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any lax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If allen arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within fitteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fitteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the filen, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security, satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and reasonable attorneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of aiforeclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surely bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shalls authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced; any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien; materialmen's lien; or other tien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all Improvements on the Reali-Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without arminimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood insurance, to the extent such insurance is required by Lender and is or becomes available, for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan, or the maximum limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall/promptly notify Liender of any-loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within fifteen: (15) days of the casualty: Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the Indebtedness, paymentiof any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall/repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburset Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration; if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal balance of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall finure to the benefit of; and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance with Existing indebtedness. During the period in which any Existing indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such Existing Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER: If:Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing, indebtedness in good-standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note-from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. However, If this Loan is a "consumer loan" or a "consumer related loan" as defined under the Indiana Uniform Consumer Credit Code; the rate charged will not exceed the Annual Percentage Rate initially disclosed on the toan. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any

applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a partiof this Mortgage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple; free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real*Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report; or finalititle opinion issued in favor of, and faccepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage; and (b) Grantor has the full right; power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defendithe title to the Property against the lawful claims of allipersons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's little or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice; and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance: With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Granton's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances; and regulations of governmental authorities.

EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Lien. The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be secondary, and inferior to an existing lien: Grantor expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

Default. If the payment of any installment of principal or any interest on the Existing Indebtedness is not made within the time required by, the note evidencing such indebtedness, or should a default occur under the instrument securing such indebtedness and not be cured; during any applicable grace period therein, then, at the option of Lender, the indebtedness secured by, this Mortgage shall become immediately due and payable, and this Mortgage shall be in default.

No Modification. Granter shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust; or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended; or renewed without the priori written consent of Lender. Granter shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain-proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and afterneys' fees incurred by Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award: Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding; but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Reali Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a)'a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all tor any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deductifrom payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principaliand interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and itake whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. Grantor hereby appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue the security interest granted in the Rents and Personal Property. Lender may sign and file financing statements without Grantor's signature. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the realiproperty records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property In a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER: ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following: provisions relating to: further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a parti of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered; to Lender or to Lender's designee; and when requested by Lender, cause to be filed, recorded; refiled, or rerecorded; as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph:

For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-factifor the purposes of making; executing; delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph:

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays allithe indebtedness when due, and otherwise performs allithe obligations imposed/upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall/execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage; and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will/pay, if permitted/by/applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default: Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is considered to the same provision of this in the same provision of this in the same provision of the

within the preceding twelve (42) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) iff Grantor, after Lender sends written notice demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within fifteen (15) days; or (b), if the cure requires more than fifteen (15) days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches: Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender, by, or, on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage; the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect;

Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of aireceiver for any partiol Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency; laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or inclana law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage.

Foreclosure, Forfeiture, etc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceedings self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. However, this subsection shalling apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure or forefeiture) proceeding, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surety-bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement: Any breach by Grantor under theiterms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is nottremedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Existing: Indebtedness. A default shall occur under any Existing Indebtedness or under any instrument on the Property, securing any Existing Indebtedness, or commencement of any suit or other action to foreclose any existing lien on the Property.

Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the indebtedness or such Guarantor dies or becomes incompetent. Lender, at its option, may, but shall not be required to, permit the Guarantor's estate to assume unconditionally the obligations arising under the guaranty in a manner satisfactory to Lender, and in doing so; cure the Event of Default:

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default andiat any time thereafter, but subject to any limitation in the Note or any limitation in this Mortgage, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire indebtedness immediately dues and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts a past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right? L'ender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rentior use fees directly to Lender. If the Rentsiare collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney—in—fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed? Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Appoint Receiver. Lender shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any partiofithe Property; with the power, to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law, i.ender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or notifie apparent value of the Property, exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property,

Deficiency Judgment. With respect to any Grantor who also is personally liable on the Note, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section. Under all circumstances, the indebtedness will be repaid without relief from any indiana or other valuation and appraisement laws.

Tenancy at Sufference. If Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Lender otherwise becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor, shall become a tenantial sufference of Lender, or the purchaser, of the Property and shall, at Lender's option, either (a) pay a reasonable rental for the user of the Property, or (b) vacate the Property immediately upon the demand of Lender.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note or available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby, waives any andfall right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Waiver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party-of-a breach of/a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict/compliance-with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy, shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender Institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the iterms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as reasonable attorneys' fees, at trial and/on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that*in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and/shall bear interest from the date of expenditure untilly repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's reasonable attorneys' fees and Lender's legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including reasonable attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

NOTICES TO GRANTORIAND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered, or when deposited with a nationally recognized overnight courier, or, if malled, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail: first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Mortgage shall be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Mortgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment:

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Indiana. This:Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or

circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances: If feasible; any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remainivalid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the indebtedness by way off forbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage or liability under the Indebtedness.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have walved any rights) under this Mörtgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such walver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay, or omission to the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a walver of such right or any other right. A walver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a walver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior walver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a walver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever, consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.
