Defendant THELONIUS HOBDY appears in person and by Nick J. Iniros. State of Indiana appears by deputy prosecutor Gary Bell. Jane Renfrow reporting. Defendant having been found guilty after trial by jury of Ct. I-Involuntary Manslaughter (C) and Ct. II-Aggravated Battery (B) this matter was continued to this date for formal sentencing. The Court is in receipt and has had an opportunity to review the presentence report said report is made available to the parties. Evidence and arguments are heard and the Court being duly advised now imposes the presumptive penalty of four (4) years in Count I, and the presumptive penalty in Count II of ten (10) years and orders said terms to be served consecutive for a total of fourteen (14) years. Defendant given credit for 413 days pretrial confinement time. Reason for the court imposing consecutive sentences is that there were two victims herein both of whom were victims of totally unnecessary shooting and the court believes deft. is in need of rehabilitative and correctional treatment that can only be provided by a significant period of confinement to a penal facility. Defendant is advised of his right to appeal and indicates he wishes to appeal but is without funds to do so. Court appoints appellate counsel Albert Marshall to perfect defendant's appeal. Clerk to notify Albert Marshall. Court costs entered of record. Bond ordered released.
