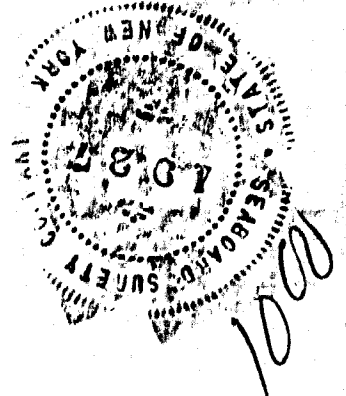
THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That whereas, the Principal has been licensed in the City of Gary, Indiana by the Oblige.

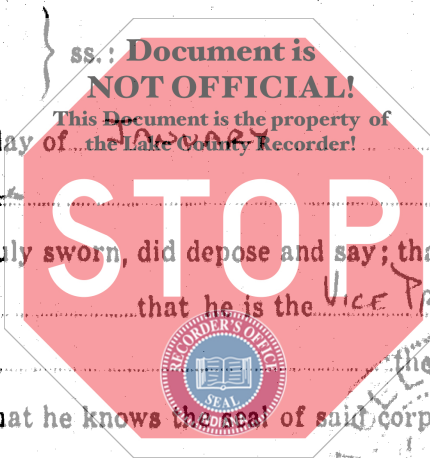

Without Limitations
