the final account, petition to settle and allow account and for
authority to distribute estate filed by Rita A. Johnson, as
Administratrix of the Estate of Walter S. Jezuit, deceased, and it
appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being
fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition
and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested
in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for
final action thereon.

2. That Walter S. Jezuit died testate, a resident of the
County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 26 day of August, 1994, and
his Last Will and Testament, dated the 24 day of June, 1975, was
duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 10 day of
November, 1994, and this Court appointed said Rita A. Johnson, as
Administratrix of his estate, and said Administratrix was issued
Letters of Administration on the 10 day of November, 1994, to her,
and since that date, she has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that said Administratrix has accounted for all the assets in said estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his Administratrix were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole devisees and legatees to the decedent's estate according to decedent's Last Will and Testament:

Walter Jezuit
Ronald Jezuit
Rita A. Johnson

and that said distribution has been made to the above-named parties as set forth above.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 324 W. 56th Place, Merrillville, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Meadowland Estates Unit 1, Lot 23, Block B.,
Parcel No. Unit 36 15-240-23.

and said real estate now vests thirty percent (30%) fee simple with Walter; thirty percent (30%) fee simple with Ronald Jezuit; and forty percent (40%) fee simple with Rita A. Johnson.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the

Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Administratrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That this distribution of the balance of the property which remained in said Administratrix's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting and prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. Said Administratrix having made a distribution of all assets and property and having attached vouchers evidencing said distribution to said legatees and devisees, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

4. Said Rita A. Johnson, as Administratrix, is hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility as said Administratrix of the Estate of Walter S. Jezuit, deceased.
