

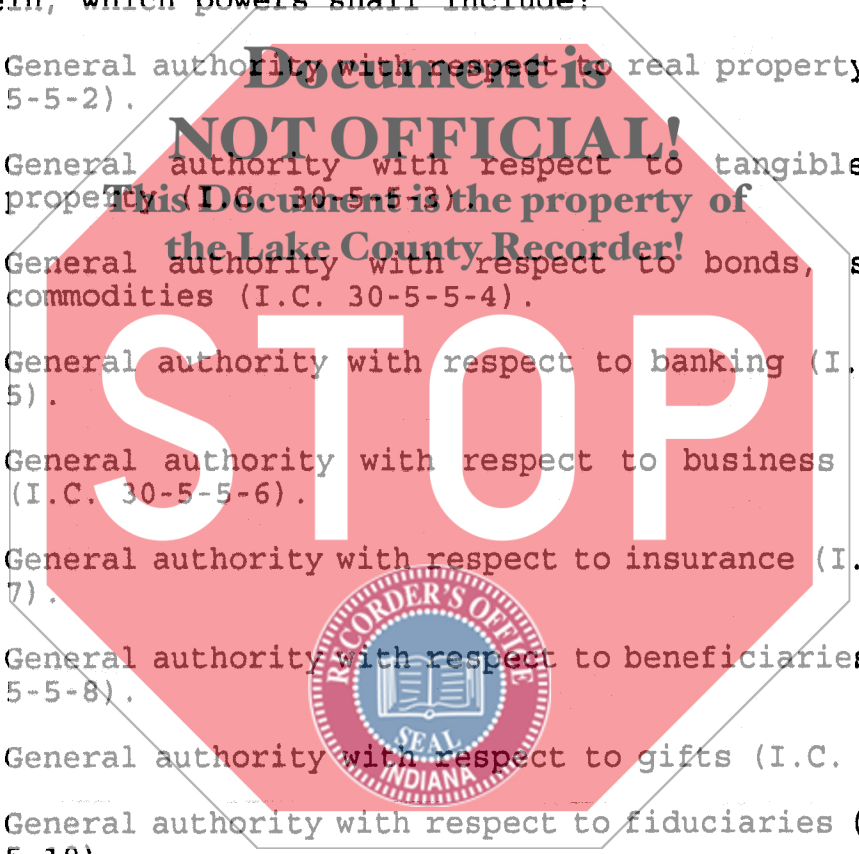

DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, Evelyn Murakowski, a resident of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, pursuant to the Indiana Power of Attorney Act (I.C. 30-5-2-1, et seq.), hereby appoint as my attorney-in-fact, Carolyn Murakowski, a resident of Shererville, Lake County, Indiana. This power of attorney shall be effective as of the 2 day of June, 1995.

My attorney-in-fact shall have all powers granted by the Indiana Power of Attorney Act (IPOA), and this instrument specifically incorporates by reference all powers set forth in the IPOA, with all descriptive language of that Act as if fully set forth herein, which powers shall include:

- 1) General authority with respect to real property (I.C. 30-5-5-2).
- 2) General authority with respect to tangible personal property (I.C. 30-5-5-3).
- 3) General authority with respect to bonds, shares and commodities (I.C. 30-5-5-4).
- 4) General authority with respect to banking (I.C. 30-5-5-5).
- 5) General authority with respect to business operations (I.C. 30-5-5-6).
- 6) General authority with respect to insurance (I.C. 30-5-5-7).
- 7) General authority with respect to beneficiaries (I.C. 30-5-5-8).
- 8) General authority with respect to gifts (I.C. 30-5-5-9).
- 9) General authority with respect to fiduciaries (I.C. 30-5-5-10).
- 10) General authority with respect to claims and litigation (I.C. 30-5-5-11).
- 11) General authority with respect to family maintenance (I.C. 30-5-5-12).
- 12) General authority with respect to benefits for military service (I.C. 30-5-5-13).
- 13) General authority with respect to records, reports and statements (I.C. 30-5-5-14).

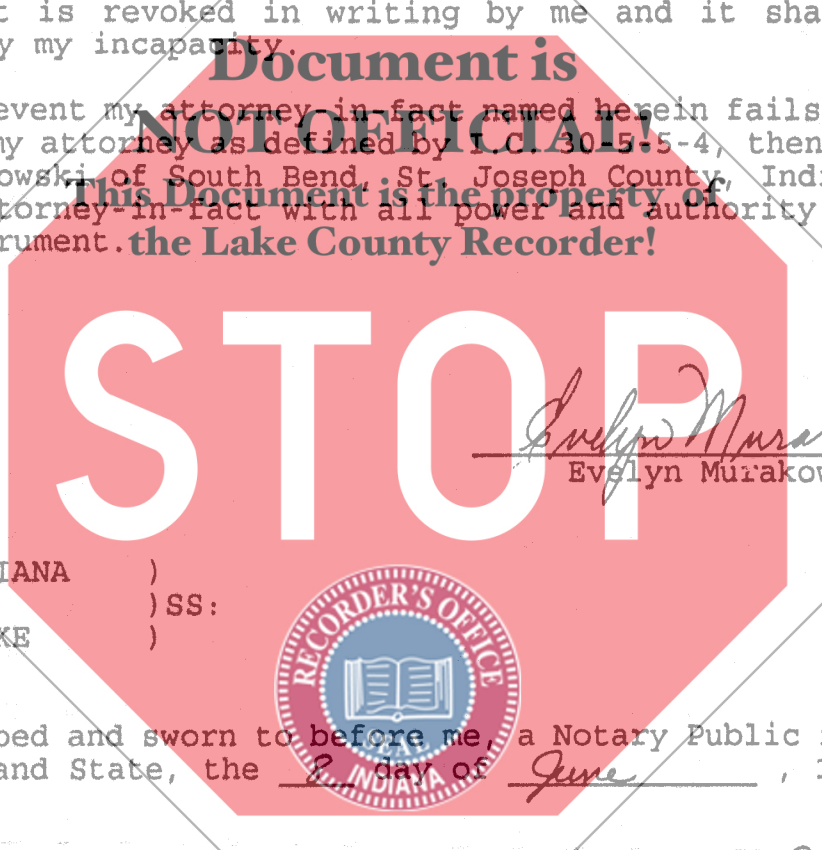
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- 14) General authority with respect to estates (I.C. 30-5-5-15).
- 15) General authority with respect to health care (I.C. 30-5-5-16) including the power to withdraw or withhold health care (I.C. 30-5-5-17) in conjunction for which I have duly executed and attached to this power of attorney a separate form of authorization and consent.
- 16) General authority as to all other matters and affairs affecting property owned by me (I.C. 30-5-5-19).

This power of attorney remains in full force and effect unless and until it is revoked in writing by me and it shall not be terminated by my incapacity.

In the event my attorney-in-fact named herein fails or ceases to serve as my attorney as defined by I.C. 30-5-5-4, then I appoint Donald Murakowski of South Bend, St. Joseph County, Indiana as my successor attorney-in-fact with all power and authority set forth in this instrument.
