**ORDER APPROVING ADMINISTRATRIX'S FINAL ACCOUNT
AND ATTENDANT PETITIONS**

This cause came to be heard on this 15th day of September, 1995, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account and for authority to distribute estate filed by MILKA ACAMOVIC as Administratrix of the Estate of BOJA PAROJCIC, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:



(H. I.)

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. BOJA PAROJCIC, died intestate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 29th day of March, 1992, and said Administratrix was issued Letters of Administration on the 14th day of April, 1992, and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.

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3. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and said Administratrix has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her Administratrix was an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The decedent died leaving the following heirs at law pursuant to the provisions of Indiana Code, I. C. 29-1-21:

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MILKA ACAMOVIC (Adult Daughter)
KOVILJKA STANKOVICH (Adult Daughter)
MILAN PAROJCIC (Adult Son)
and the following children of a deceased son (DANIEL PAROJCIC):
ANGIE
STEFANIE
NICHOLAS.



ANGIE PAROJCIC is an adult of 21 years of age. STEFANIE PAROJCIC is 19 years of age. NICHOLAS PAROJCIC is 17 years of age.

The net assets of this Estate should be divided into twelve shares. Three shares each for the adult children MILKA, KOVILJKA and MILAN, and one share each for grandchildren ANGIE, STEFANIE and NICHOLAS.

6. The decedent owned the following real estate at the time of her death, to-wit:

a. Lot 19 and the North 8 feet of Lot 20 in Block 5 of the Fourth Addition to Indiana Harbor in East Chicago, Indiana, more commonly known as 3737 Drummond, East Chicago, Indiana, and which was sold on October 15, 1993 pursuant to this Court's Order dated December 4, 1992. *key # 30-384-18*

b. Lots 13 and 14 in Block 2 of White Oak Manor of the First Re-Subdivision of the City of Hammond, commonly known as 1232 - 175th Street, Hammond, Indiana, which was sold on November 4, 1993 pursuant to this Court's Order dated September 10, 1993. *key # 36-327-13, #14*

c. Lot 6 in Block 8, of the Cline Garden Addition to the City of Hammond, commonly known as 6722 Rhode Island, Hammond, Indiana and which was sold on July 14, 1994 pursuant to this Court's Order dated December 4, 1992.

d. Lot 27 in Block 6 of Gary Land Company's Subdivision in Gary commonly known as 806 Monroe, Gary, Indiana which your Petitioner was unable to sell for lack of a buyer. *key # 36-327-13, #14*

The remaining lot, (parcel "d" above) should have its title vested in the six heirs in this Estate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Administratrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. The distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said Administratrix's hands for distribution should be made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit:


Lot 27 in Block 6 of Gary Land Company's Subdivision in Gary commonly known as 806 Monroe, Gary, Indiana is hereby vested in the following people, all as tenants in common:

- One-Fourth interest to MILKA ACAMOVIC
- One-Fourth interest to KOVILJKA STANKOVICH
- One-Fourth interest to MILAN PAROJCIC
- One-Twelfth interest to ANGIE PAROJCIC
- One-Twelfth interest to STEFANIE PAROJCIC
- One-Twelfth interest to NICHOLAS PAROJCIC.

4. The Administratrix, after payment of her fees and fees due her attorney, is directed to distribute the balance of assets remaining in the estate in the following manner:

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One-Fourth interest to MILKA ACAMOVIC
One-Fourth interest to KOVILJKA STANKOVICH
One-Fourth interest to MILAN PAROJCIC
One-Twelfth interest to ANGIE PAROJCIC
One-Twelfth interest to STEFANIE PAROJCIC
One-Twelfth interest to NICHOLAS PAROJCIC, (TO BE PAID IN CARE OF NICHOLAS' NATURAL MOTHER)

5. Said Administratrix is hereby directed to file her Supplemental Report showing that she has complied with the terms of this order and that said Administratrix has in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree. All of which is ordered this 15th day of September, 1995.
