GARDNER as personal prepresentative of the estate of WILLIAM H. GARDNER, deceased, which account and petition are on file with the Court and a part of the Count's record.

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto Court, being fully advised in the premises, now-finds that;

- Due notice of the filing of said accounting and petition the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said That a formal notice was published pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 29-1-16-6 and that this matter is now properly before the Court for final action thereon:
- That WILLIAM H. GARDNER died testate a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 6th day of May 1992, and his Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 21st day of October 1992, and this Court appointed CHARLES D. GARDNER as personal representative of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said personal representative was issued Letters

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Testamentary on the 21st day of October 1992, and since that date, he has continued to serve in such capacity;

- 3. That the matters and things stated in said accounting and petition are true, and that said personal representative has accounted for all assets in this estate coming into his hands;
- 4. That more than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; no claims were filed against said estate; neither said decedent nor his personal representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act, and any inheritance taxed owing in said estate; Federal and State Income Taxes; if any cassessed in said estate have been paid;
- 5. That the following persons are the legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament;

Claude Thomas Gardner, adult brother, 1/4th of value of real property and 1/4th of value of rest and residue of estate.

Alfred Lee Cardoex, adult brother, 1/4th of value of real property and 1/4th of value of rest and residue of estate.

James Robert Gardner, adult brother, 1/4th of value of rest and residue of estate.

Charles D. Gardner, adult brother, 1/4th of value of real property and 1/4th of value of rest and residue of estate.

That all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and costs of administration have been distributed to the above-named persons; as evidence by their receipts which are attached hereto and made a part of this accounting;

6. That the decedent individually owned a certain piece of real estate located at 1526 - 173rd Street, Hammond, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

and that the decedent devised said real property in Paragraph Two of his Last Will and Testament Claude Thomas GARDNER, ALFRED LEE GARDNER, JAMES ROBERN GARDNER and CHARLES LD. CARDNER which real property vested upon the death of decedent to the above said devisees the Lake County Recorder!

as tenants in common each having a 1/4th interest therein.

7. That all expenses of the estate, excluding attorney fees and incidental administration costs, have now been paid;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

- 1. Said Final Report and Accounting of said personal representative is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.
- 2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said personal representative's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.
- 3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real property, to-wit:

Lot No. Seven (7), in Block No. One (1) as marked and laid down on the

recorded plat of Saxony Park Addition, being a subdivision of the Easterly part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 36 North, Range 9 West of the Second Principal Meridian, in Lake County, Indiana, as the same appears of record in Plat Book 16, page 8, in the Recorder's Office of Lake County, Indiana.


- 4.
