## POWER OF ATTORNEY

Know all men by these Presents, the UTICA MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY, as a New York Corporation, having its principal office in the Town of New Harrford. County of Oneida, State of New York, does hereby make, constitute and appoint Jeanne M. Downs, John J. Naso, Jr., Peggy Meyer Marie S. Fuesel, Kimberlee A. Messere, Joanne C. Duda, Marlene Cartwright  Orlando Park, Illinois its true and lawful Attorney(s)-in-fact in their separate capacity if more than one is named above to make, execute, sign, seal and delivery for and on its behalf as surety and as its act and deed (without power of redelegation) any and all bonds and undertakings and other writings obligatory in the nature thereof (except bonds guaranteeing the payment of principal and interest of notes, mortgage bonds and mortgages) provided the amount of no one bond or undertaking exceeds  Five Hundred Thousand & OO/100 Dollars (S 500,000,00).
