This bond may be terminated at any time by the Surety upon sending written notice to the clerk of the Political Subdivision  
with whom this bond is filed and to the Principal, addressed to them at their first known address, and at the expiration of thirty  
(30) days from the mailing of said notice, this bond shall terminate and the Surety shall thereupon be relieved from any liability  
for any acts or omissions of the Principal.

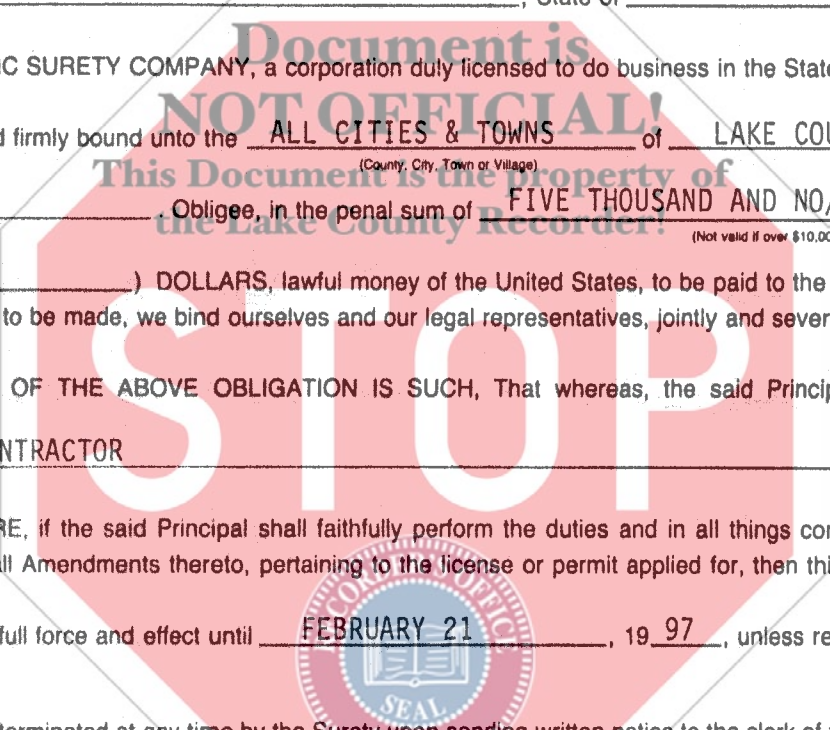
