RESOLUTION NO. 302

SECTION 1. He it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Griffith, Indiana, that it is hereby deemed and declared necessary that a new street should be and the same is hereby opened, laid out and established as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 23, Township 36 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd P.M., in Lake County, Indiana, and running thence North 40 feet, running thence East 1 mile, running thence South 80 feet, running thence West 1 mile, running thence North 40 feet to the place of beginning, and that all lands contained within the above described tract which have not heretofore been appropriated for public use be and the same are nereby appropriated and condemned for the purpose of a public street in said Town.

IN THE MATTER OF THE OPENING A NEW STREET IN THE TOWN OF GRIFFITH, INDIANA AS PROVIDED FOR IN RESOLUTION NO. 302

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Town Board that due notice was given, by posting of notices by the Town Marshall in three public and conspicuous places in said town on October 11th, 1928 and by publication of notice in the Lake County Times on the 12th and 19th days of October 1928, in the Gary Post Tribune on the 13th and 20th days of October 1928, of the passage of Resolution No. 302, being a Resolution for the opening and establishing of a new street as therein described, which was passed and adopted at the regular meeting of the Board held on the 5th day of October, 1928, fixing this date as the time and place at which the Board would receive and hear remonstrances from persons interested in, or affected by said proceedings, and the Board being satisfied that the posting and publication of said notices was in due form and according to law, it was publicly announced that the Board would receive and hear all remonstrances from persons affected by said proceedings.

Thereupon the following named persons appeared and remonstrated to the proceedings, to-wit: Horace Lohse and Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railroad Company, and the Board after hearing all remonstrances, and after being fully advised in the premises, it was moved by Grimmer and seconded by Christenson, that said remonstrances be taken under advisement until the next regular meeting.
