



(2) the nature and circumstances of the crime committed are as follows: the defendant arrived during an argument between the victim and the defendant's cousin, and the defendant stabbed the victim;

(3) the defendant's prior criminal record is as follows: as an adult in 1994, intimidation in Lake Station, Indiana;

(4) the defendant's character is as follows: violent;

(5) the defendant's condition is as follows: a 28 year old, practicing Catholic, with a history of depression.

II Mitigating circumstances:

The defendant has no significant history of delinquency or criminal activity, or he has led a law-abiding life for a substantial period before commission of the crime. The defendant is likely to respond affirmatively to probation because he has not previously had the benefits of prolonged supervision.

III Aggravating circumstances:

none.

The court also finds that the defendant shall be given twenty-one (21) days credit toward the sentence of imprisonment for time spent in confinement as a result of this charge, and the court recommends that said time be considered as good time credit provided by law. The bond previously posted on behalf of the defendant is ordered released after payment of the court fees. (Marianna Novak reporting.)
