and Calumet Securities Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Indiana

(hereinafter called Mortgagee),

WITNESSETH: That whereas the Mortgagor is justly indebted to the Mortgagee for money borrowed in the principal sum of **Ninety Three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty and no/100** Dollars (\$93,840.00), as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, with interest from date at the rate of **Eight per centum (8.000%)** per annum on the unpaid balance until paid, the said principal and interest to be payable at the office of

or at such other place as the holder may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of **Six Hundred Eighty Eight and 57/100** Dollars (\$688.57), commencing on the first day of **June, 1996**, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that, if not sooner paid, the final payment of the entire indebtedness evidenced thereby shall be due and payable on the first day of **May, 2026**.

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the premises, and for the purpose of securing the payment of the money aforesaid and interest thereon according to the tenor and effect of the said promissory note, above mentioned, and also to secure the faithful performance of all the covenants, conditions, stipulations and agreements herein contained, does by these presents, mortgage and warrant unto the Mortgagee, all of the following-described property, situated in the Schererville in the county of Lake and State of Indiana, to wit:

LOT 6, PARK MANOR 5TH ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF SCHERERVILLE, AS PER PLAT THEREOF, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 29, PAGE 57, IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

together with all buildings or improvements now or hereafter thereon, and hereditaments and appurtenances and all other rights thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions, remainders, and the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises; and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are, and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned:

THE MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS that:

1. Mortgagor is the owner of said premises in fee simple or such other estate as is stated herein.

2. Mortgagor will pay the indebtedness as provided in said note and this mortgage. Privilege is reserved to prepay at any time, without premium or fee, the entire indebtedness or any part thereof not less than the amount of one installment, or one hundred (\$100), whichever is less. Prepayment in full shall be credited on the date received. Partial prepayment, other than on an installment due date, need not be credited until the next following installment due date or thirty days after such prepayment, whichever is earlier.

3. Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee, as trustee (under the terms of this trust as hereinafter stated) together with, in addition to, the monthly payments under the terms of the note secured hereby, on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid:

- (a) A sum equal to the ground rents, if any, next due, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by Mortgagee, and of which the Mortgagor is notified) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments.
- (b) The aggregate of the amounts payable pursuant to subparagraph (a) and those payable on the note secured hereby, shall be paid in a single payment each month, to be applied to the following items in the order stated:
- (I) ground rents, taxes, special assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums;
 - (II) interest on the note secured hereby; and
 - (III) amortization of the principal of said note.

Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. At Mortgagee's option, Mortgagor will pay a "late charge" not exceeding four per centum (4%) of any installment when paid more than fifteen (15) days after the due date thereof to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments, but such "late charge" shall not be payable out of the proceeds of any sale made to satisfy the indebtedness secured hereby, unless such proceeds are sufficient to discharge the entire indebtedness and all proper costs and expenses secured hereby.

4. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (a) of paragraph 3 preceding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee as trustee for ground rents, taxes or assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor for such items or, at Mortgagee's option, as trustee, shall be refunded to Mortgagor. If, however, such monthly payments shall not be sufficient to pay such items when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee as trustee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency. Such payments shall be made within thirty (30) days after written notice from the Mortgagee stating the amount of the deficiency, which notice may be given by mail. If at any time Mortgagor shall tender to Mortgagee, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hereby, full payment of the entire indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagee, as trustee shall, in computing the amount of such indebtedness, credit to the account of the Mortgagor any credit balance remaining under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 3 hereof. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby or if the Mortgagee acquires the property otherwise after default, the Mortgagee as trustee, shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the amount then remaining to the credit of Mortgagor under (a) of paragraph 3 preceding, as a credit on the interest accrued and unpaid and the balance to the principal then remaining unpaid on said note.

5. Mortgagor will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or impositions, except when payment for all such items has theretofore been made under (a) of paragraph 3 hereof and in default thereof the Mortgagee may pay the same; and will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to said Mortgagee.

6. Mortgagor will not commit, permit, or suffer waste, impairment, or deterioration of said property or any part thereof, and in the event of the failure of the Mortgagor to keep the buildings and other improvements now or hereafter on said premises in good repair, the Mortgagee may make such repairs as may reasonable be deemed necessary for the proper preservation thereof and the sum so paid shall bear interest from date at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness, shall be payable thirty (30) days after demand, and shall be fully secured by this mortgage.

7. Mortgagor will continuously maintain hazard insurance, of such type or types and amounts as Mortgagee may from time to time require, on the improvements now or hereafter on said premises, and except when payment for all such premiums has theretofore been made under (a) of paragraph 3 hereof, he/she will pay promptly when due any premiums therefor. In default thereof, the Mortgagee may pay the same. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by Mortgagee and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. In event of loss Mortgagor will give immediate notice by mail to Mortgagee, and Mortgagee may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to Mortgagee instead of to Mortgagor and Mortgagee jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by Mortgagee at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage or other transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

8. In case proceedings to foreclose this mortgage are instituted, any sums necessarily expended for the continuation of the abstract of title to the above-described real estate, together with interest thereon at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness, shall become a part of the debt secured by this mortgage shall be collectible as such.

9. Upon the request of the Mortgagee, the Mortgagor shall execute and deliver a supplemental note or notes for the sum or sums advanced by the Mortgagee for the alteration, modernization, improvement, maintenance, or repair of said premises, for taxes or assessments against the same and for any other purpose authorized hereunder. Said note or notes shall be secured hereby on a parity with and as fully as if the advance evidenced thereby were included in the note first described above. Said supplemental note or notes shall bear interest at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness and shall be payable in approximately equal monthly payments for such period as may be agreed upon by the creditor and debtor. Failing to agree on the maturity, the whole of the sum or sums so advanced with interest thereon at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness shall be due and payable thirty (30) days after demand by the creditor. In no event shall the maturity extend beyond the ultimate maturity of the note first described above.

VA GUARANTEED LOAN AND ASSUMPTION POLICY RIDER

THIS V.A. GUARANTEED LOAN AND ASSUMPTION POLICY RIDER is made this first day of May, 1996, and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Deed to Secure Debt (herein "Security Instrument") dated of even date herewith, given by the undersigned (herein "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Note to Calumet Securities Corporation

(herein "Lender")

and covering the Property described in the Security Instrument and located at
335 East Joliet Street
Scherville, IN 46375
(Property Address)

V.A. GUARANTEED LOAN COVENANT: In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

If the indebtedness secured hereby be guaranteed or insured under Title 38, United States Code, such Title and Regulations issued thereunder and in effect on the date hereof shall govern the rights, duties and liabilities of Borrower and Lender. Any provisions of the Security Instrument or other instruments executed in connection with said indebtedness which are inconsistent with said Title or Regulations, including, but not limited to, the provision for payment of any sum in connection with prepayment of the secured indebtedness and the provision that the Lender may accelerate payment of the secured indebtedness pursuant to Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument, are hereby amended or negated to the extent necessary to conform such instruments to said Title or Regulations.

LATE CHARGE: At Lender's option, Borrower will pay a "late charge" not exceeding four per centum (4%) of the overdue payment of principal and interest when paid more than fifteen (15) days after the due date thereof to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments, but such "late charge" shall not be payable out of the proceeds of any sale made to satisfy the indebtedness secured hereby, unless such proceeds are sufficient to discharge the entire indebtedness and all proper costs and expenses secured hereby.

GUARANTY: Should the Department of Veterans Affairs fail or refuse to issue its guaranty in full amount within 60 days from the date that this loan would normally become eligible for such guaranty committed upon by the Department of Veterans Affairs under the provisions of Title 38 of the U.S. Code "Veterans Benefits," the Mortgagee may declare the indebtedness hereby secured at once due and payable and may foreclose immediately or may exercise any other rights hereunder or take any other proper action as by law provided.

TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY: If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred this loan may be declared immediately due and payable upon transfer ("assumption") of the property securing such loan to any transferee ("assumer"), unless the acceptability of the assumption and transfer of this loan is established by the Department of Veterans Affairs or its authorized agent pursuant to Section 1814 of Chapter 37, Title 38, United States Code.

REAMORTIZATION OR ADJUSTMENT OF DEBT: The interest rate, payment terms, or balance due on the loan may be indexed, adjusted, renewed or renegotiated by the Grantors under the Deed of Trust or their successors in interest and the Beneficiary under the Deed of Trust or its successors in interest. In no event shall the interest rate be increased beyond the prevailing VA rate at the time the loan was closed. The provisions of this paragraph are hereby deemed to be incorporated within the terms of the Deed of Trust and the Deed of Trust Note secured by this Deed of Trust.

An authorized transfer ("assumption") of the property shall also be subject to additional covenants and agreements as set forth below:

(a) **ASSUMPTION FUNDING FEE:** A fee equal to one-half of 1 percent (.50%) of the unpaid principal balance of this loan as of the date of transfer of the property shall be payable at the time of transfer to the mortgagee or its authorized agent, as trustee for the Department of Veterans Affairs. If the assumer fails to pay this fee at the time of transfer, the fee shall constitute an additional debt to that already secured by this instrument, shall bear interest at the rate herein provided, and, at the option of the mortgagee of the indebtedness hereby secured or any transferee thereof, shall be immediately due and payable. This fee is automatically waived if the assumer is exempt under the provisions of 38 U.S.C. 1829 (b).

(b) **ASSUMPTION PROCESSING CHARGE:** Upon application for approval to allow assumption and transfer of this loan, a processing fee may be charged by the mortgagee or its authorized agent for determining the creditworthiness of the assumer and subsequently revising the holder's ownership records when an approved transfer is completed. The amount of this charge shall not exceed the maximum established by the Department of Veterans Affairs for a loan to which section 1817A of Chapter 37, Title 38, United States Code applies.

(c) **ASSUMPTION INDEMNITY LIABILITY:** If this obligation is assumed, then the assumer hereby agrees to assume all of the obligations of the veteran under the terms of the instruments creating and securing the loan, including the obligation of the veteran to indemnify the Department of Veterans Affairs to the extent of any claim payment arising from the guaranty or insurance of the indebtedness created by this instrument.

DVA LOAN ASSUMPTION RIDER TO DEED OF TRUST/MORTGAGE

This VA Loan Assumption Rider is made this first day of May, 1996, and amends the provisions of the Deed of Trust/Mortgage ("Security Instrument") of the same date, by and between Michael K. Dobberstein and Karen L. Dobberstein, husband and wife, the Trustors/Mortgagors, and Calumet Securities Corporation, The Beneficiary/Mortgagee as follows:
Adds the following provisions:

THIS LOAN IS NOT ASSUMABLE WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OR ITS AUTHORIZED AGENT.


This loan is immediately due and payable upon transfer of the property securing such loan to any transferee, unless the acceptability of the assumption of the loan is established pursuant to section 1817A of chapter 37, title 38, United States Code.

- A. FUNDING FEE.** A fee equal to one-half of 1 percent of the balance of this loan as of the date of transfer of the property shall be payable at the time of transfer to the loan holder or its authorized agent, as trustee for the Secretary of Veteran's Affairs, an officer of the United States Government. If the assumer fails to pay this fee at the time of transfer, the fee shall constitute an additional debt to that already secured by this instrument, shall bear interest at the rate herein provided, and, at the option of the mortgagee of the indebtedness hereby secured or any transferee thereof, shall be immediately due and payable. This fee is automatically waived if the assumer is exempt under the provisions of 38 U.S.C. 1829 (b).
- (B) PROCESSING CHARGE.** Upon application for approval to allow assumption of this loan, a processing fee may be charged by the loan holder or its authorized agent for determining the creditworthiness of the assumer and subsequently revising the holder's ownership records when an approved transfer is completed. The amount of this charge shall not exceed the maximum established by the Department of Veterans Affairs for a loan to which section 1817A of Chapter 37, Title 38, United States Code applies.
- (C) INDEMNITY LIABILITY.** "If this obligation is assumed, then the assumer hereby agrees to assume all of the obligations of the veteran under the terms of the instruments creating and securing the loan, including the obligation of the veteran to indemnify the Department of Veterans Affairs to the extent of any claim payment arising from the guaranty or insurance of the indebtedness created by this instrument."
