DECREE OF DISSOLUTION

Comes now petitioner, KATHLYN D. BELLI, and by her attorney, Thomas L. Kirsch, and comes now respondent, JOSEPH BELLI, and by his attorney, JERRY I. SHAPIRO. Petitioner, having previously filed her Verified Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, now shows that respondent was duly and legally served with summons by certified mail. Petitioner further shows the Court that this cause has been filed and legally pending for more than sixty (60) days, and this cause being now at issue, is now submitted to the Court for trial, finding, and judgment. Petitioner and respondent file written Waivers of Final Hearing, pursuant to I.C. 31-1-11.5-8(d).

The Court, being duly advised and having reviewed said Waivers and Custody and Property Settlement Agreement, and petitioner's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, NOW FINDS that the marriage of the parties is irretrievably broken, there is no reasonable possibility of reconciliation, and therefore, said marriage should be dissolved; that the Custody and Property Settlement Agreement concerning property rights and division of property which has heretofore been executed by petitioner and respondent is not unconscionable and same is approved by the Court and made a part of this Decree the same as if the provisions and terms thereof were fully recited herein, and each of the parties is ordered and directed by the Court to carry out the terms and provisions of this agreement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by this Court that each of the parties carry out the terms and provisions of the agreement concerning the division of property which has heretofore been signed in this action and made a part of this Decree.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that petitioner's former name of KATHLYN D. HOLLAND be restored to her.

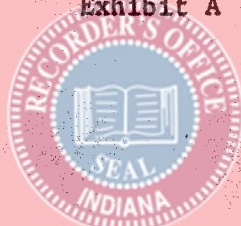
