We represent Bulkmatic Transport Company. Bulkmatic recently received a copy of OPC Communications, Inc.'s Sworn Statement and Notice of Intention to Hold Lien on the property commonly known as 2001 North Cline Avenue, Griffith, Indiana 46319 (the "Project").

As you may know, Indiana's Mechanic's Lien Act provides that any subcontractor who wishes to enforce a mechanic's lien against certain property must file and record with the recorder of deeds for the county where the property is located his notice of intent to hold a lien within sixty (60) days of last furnishing labor or materials to a construction project.

Bulkmatic's records show that OPC performed work at the Project in question as a subcontractor of Block Technologies during the third week of March, 1996, but no later than March 31, 1996, including all punch list items.
