 for any acts or omissions of the Principal.

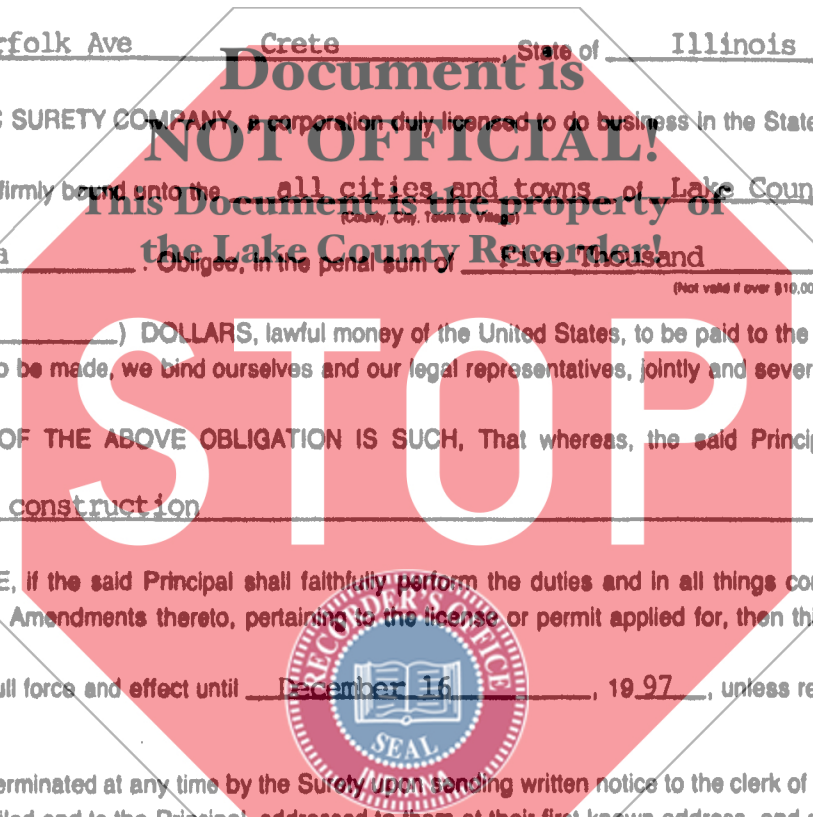
