AFFIDAVIT OF SURVIVORSHIP

Comes now John L. Lain, Jr. Personal Representative of the estate of Edith Lain, deceased, being duly sworn upon his oath and states as follows:

1. That Edith Lain, at the time of her death, was the surviving spouse of John L. Lain, Sr. and the owner in fee simple of the following described Real Estate located in Lake County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot 7, except the Easterly 35 feet thereof and except the Southerly 82 feet thereof, Lot 6, except the Southerly 82 feet thereof; that part of Lot 5 lying Westerly of a tract described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot 7, thence Northerly on the Easterly line of Lot 7 produced to the Northerly line of Block 8; thence Westerly along said Northerly line 38.29 feet, thence Southerly parallel to said Easterly line of Lot 7 produced to a point on the Southerly line of Lot 5; thence Easterly along said Southerly line to the point of beginning; all in Block 8 in Earle and Davis' Addition to the Town (now City) of Hobart, as per plat thereof, recorded in Miscellaneous Record "A" page 486, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.
