3. There was no inheritance or federal estate tax due as a result of the death of Pearl Seehausen and her last bills and debts, including the funeral bill, have been paid.

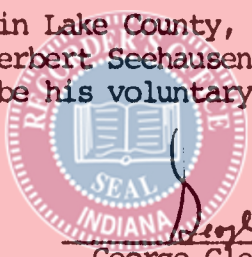
