EXHIBIT "A" LEGAL DESCRIPTION

PARCEL I:

The East 1182 feet of that part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 9, Township 35 North, Range 8 West of the 2nd Principal Meridian, in the Town of Merrillville, Lake County, Indiana, lying Northerly of the Northerly right of way line of the Chicago and Grand Trunk Railway Company, except the North 650 feet thereof, and except therefrom that part of said tract lying South of a line which begins on the East line thereof at a point 241 feet North of the intersection of said East line and the Northerly right of way of said Railroad and extends West at right angles to said East line a distance of 1175.6 feet to the Northerly right of way line of said Railway Company. also excepting that part, if any, lying West of the East line of the West 1478.40 feet of the South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of said section, in Lake County, Indiana.
