

Legal Description

Parcel 1

The North 339 feet of the West 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, except the North 150 feet of the South 200 feet thereof, of Section 29, Township 36 North, Range 7 West, of the Second Principal Meridian, in Lake County, Indiana.

Part of the North 14 acres of the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 29, Township 36 North, Range 7 West, of the Second Principal Meridian, in Lake County, Indiana, described as follows:
