WHEREAS, the Lake Central School Corporation has petitioned the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana to disannex certain contiguous territory to the Town of St. John pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-4-3-17 et seq; and

WHEREAS, said petitioner has executed a Petition for Disannexation, which is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, said petitioner has indicated that the boundaries of the property form a part of the corporate boundary of the Town; that the property is no longer in the economic and social interest of the Town of St. John and that it extends beyond the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John; and that the Town of St. John obtains no taxes on the property, and will not in the future; and

WHEREAS, said petitioner has alleged that it is financially unfeasible to provide necessary services to the property in the reasonably near future; that necessary services have not been provided to the property in over 30 years; and that it would now be impossible to provide necessary services to the property since the property is in the Schererville utility district; and

WHEREAS, the property has been utilized as a road and the petitioner herein has entered into an agreement with a diveloper whereby it will convert the private road into a public road with improvements being made to the same; and
