Anson as Personal Representative of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said Personal Representative was issued Letters Testamentary on the 13th day of May, 1997, and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.

- 3. That the matters and things stated in said accounting and Petition are true, and said Personal Representative has accounted for all the assets in this estate coming into her hands.
- 4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to legatees, devisees, and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his Personal Representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; and all estate taxes, inheritance taxes, and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.
- 5. That the following person is the sole legatee and devisee under the decedent's Last
 Will and Testament:

Elizabeth A. Anson, Wife

and said distribution should be made to the above-named party as set forth above.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 5012 Calhoun Street, Griffith, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as:
