

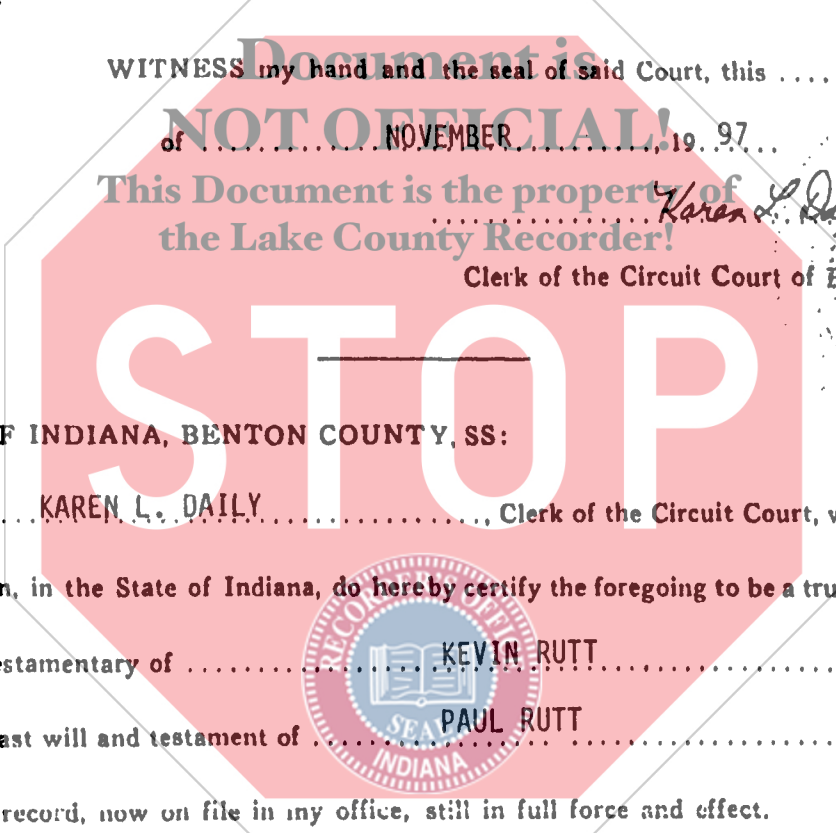

**ORDER PROBATING WILL AND APPOINTING PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDERING UNSUPERVISED ADMINISTRATION WITHOUT BOND**


Comes now, Paul Rutt, having filed his verified petition for the probate of decedent's will, issuance of letters, and for unsupervised administration without bond of the decedent's estate, which petition is on file with the court and a part of the court's record.

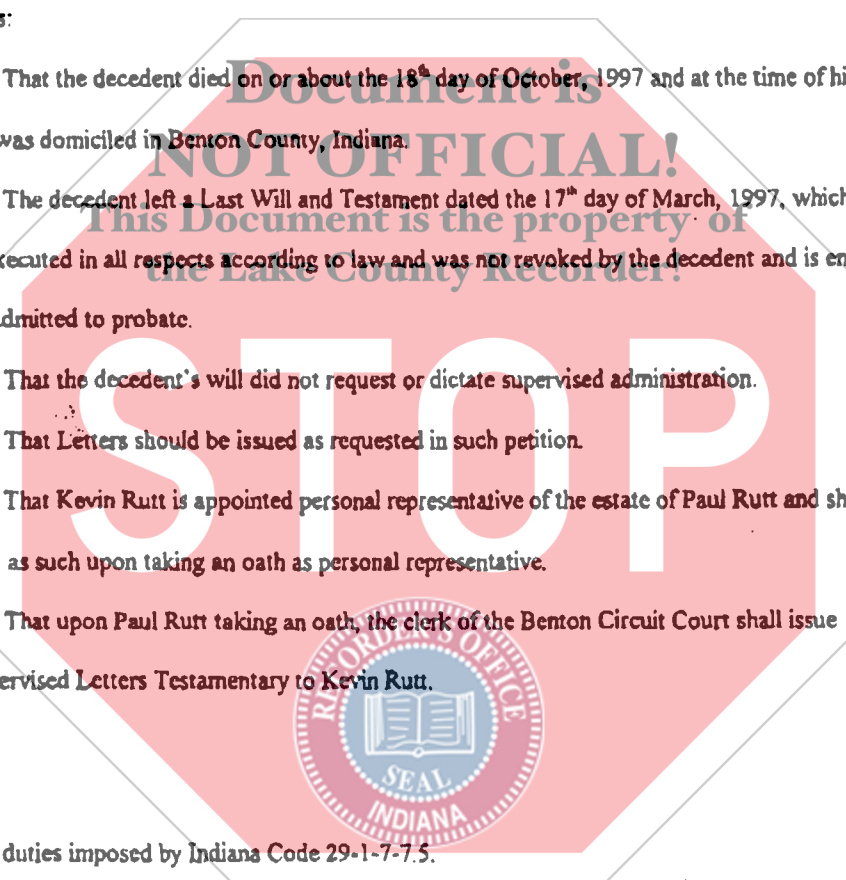
The court having examined the petition and being duly advised in the premises now finds as follows:

1. That the decedent died on or about the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1997 and at the time of his death was domiciled in Benton County, Indiana.
2. The decedent left a Last Will and Testament dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1997, which was duly executed in all respects according to law and was not revoked by the decedent and is entitled to be admitted to probate.
3. That the decedent's will did not request or dictate supervised administration.
4. That Letters should be issued as requested in such petition.
5. That Kevin Rutt is appointed personal representative of the estate of Paul Rutt and should qualify as such upon taking an oath as personal representative.
6. That upon Paul Rutt taking an oath, the clerk of the Benton Circuit Court shall issue Unsupervised Letters Testamentary to Kevin Rutt.

7. That Kevin Rutt as personal representative of the estate of Paul Rutt is hereby authorized to proceed under the statutory provisions of the Indiana Code governing unsupervised administration of estates.

8. That the personal representative is further ordered to notify all reasonably ascertainable creditors of the decedent and to comply with the notice requirements of Indiana Code 29-1-7-7 and the duties imposed by Indiana Code 29-1-7-7.5.
