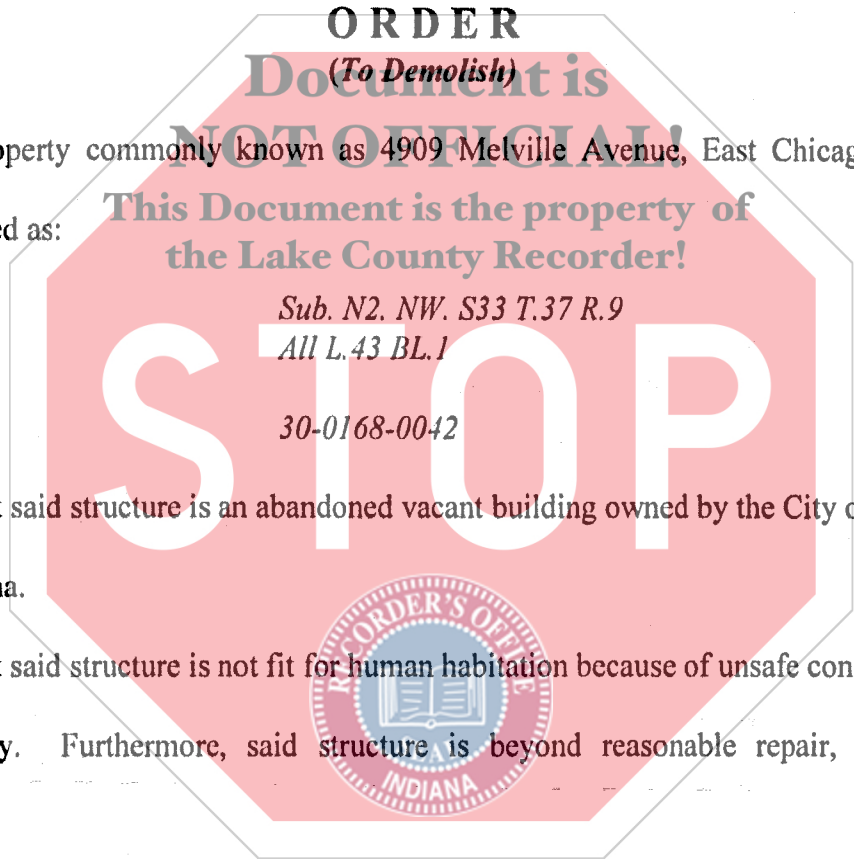

1. That said structure is an abandoned vacant building owned by the City of East Chicago, Indiana.
2. That said structure is not fit for human habitation because of unsafe conditions and structural decay. Furthermore, said structure is beyond reasonable repair, renovation or rehabilitation.
3. That said structure is an eyesore and a nuisance to the neighborhood and attracts the criminal element who are known to use this location as a meeting place, or haven to escape from law enforcement agencies.
4. That the East Chicago Police Department has certified said structure as being used

for illicit and unlawful activity, including but not limited to the presence of illegal drugs and drug related activity.

5. That the structure meets the criteria established under the Operation Crackdown Program; therefore, making it eligible for demolition by the Indiana National Guard.

THEREOFRE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That, pursuant to the authority of the Building Commissioner, the Indiana National Guard under the Operation Crackdown Program, tear down, demolish, and clean said property of all debris, rubbish and material within thirty (30) days of notice of this Order.
