

**COUNTY UNIFIED BOND**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That

KPS Construction, Inc  
of Griffith Indiana

as Principal and AMERICAN STATES INSURANCE COMPANY duly authorized to transact surety business in the State of Indiana, as Surety, as held and firmly bound unto

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if the above bounden Principal shall on and after the 31st day of March, 1999, indemnify said Obligees against all loss, costs, expense or damage to it caused by said Principal's non-compliance with or breach of any laws, statutes, ordinances, rules or regulations pertaining to such license or permit, then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.

**Provided**, the term of the bond is continuous.

AND, PROVIDED, the Surety may cancel this bond at any time by giving thirty (30) days notice in writing mailed to the Obligees.

PROVIDED FURTHER, regardless of the number of years this bond shall continue or be continued in force and of the number of premiums that shall be payable or paid, the Surety shall not be liable hereunder for a larger amount, in the aggregate, than the amount of this bond.

PROVIDED FURTHER, regardless of the number of licenses held by the Principal within the County and the number of claims that may be filed against this bond either under a single license, the total of which may exceed the penalty of this bond, the Surety shall not be liable hereunder for a larger amount, in the aggregate, than the amount of this bond.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that this bond shall be not construed to provide indemnity as a result of the Principal's failure to perform the terms of a construction contract.

Extract from the By-Laws of AMERICAN STATES INSURANCE COMPANY

"Article 8, Section 8.1 1. - FIDELITY AND SURETY BONDS ... the President, any Vice President, the Secretary, and any Assistant Vice President appointed for that purpose by the officer in charge of surety operations, shall each have authority to appoint individuals as attorneys-in-fact or under other appropriate titles with authority to execute on behalf of the corporation fidelity and surety bonds and other documents of similar character issued by the corporation in the course of its business.... On any instrument making or evidencing such appointment, the signatures may be affixed by facsimile.
