This Document is the property of the Lake County Recorder!

During our project coordination meeting on Friday, January 8, 1999 we discussed the status of the proposed levee projects on both sides of the EJ&E Railroad near River Road in the Town of Griffith. Mr. Ken Hay requested additional information for the levee construction on the west side of the railroad embankment. Enclosed you will find the following information:

- A. Plan and profile drawing of the proposed levee construction
- B. Two sheets of cross-sections showing existing and proposed grades
- C. A copy of the May 29, 1998 letter to the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Division of Water and portions of the appendices which may be of interest.
- D. Sections 201 (Clearing and Grubbing) and 203 (Excavation and Embankment) of the Indiana Department of Transportation's Standard Specifications (1995 Edition) which will pertain to the construction for this project.

For your information, Richard Kortenhoven has already lined up a Contractor and the source of fill for the levee construction. Samples of the clay material to be used were taken to K&S Engineers, Inc. of Highland, Indiana for testing and recommendation for the soil strength parameters to be used in the slope stability analysis. The results of the testing and slope stability analysis are included with the May 29, 1998 letter referenced in item C above. The proposed embankment section and fill material resulted in acceptable factors of safety for slope stability. The INDOT specifications will dictate that the site be cleared and grubbed, all unsuitable subgrade materials be removed, that the fill material be compacted based on maximum dry densities unless otherwise specified or directed and that the railroad embankment be deeply scarified or benched prior to construction.

Please review the enclosed attachments and let me know if you need any further information. As we discussed in the meeting, it was decided that this information would be forwarded to you for copying and distribution to the EJ&E Railroad and the Army Corps of Engineers and any other
