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CLARIFICATION STATEMENT

- 1. On March 22, 1995 the Transferor sold a small parcel of real property to the State of Indiana. That parcel is marked "Not Included" in Exhibit "A," which is attached to the Environmental Disclosure Document For Transfer Of Real Property to which this Clarification Statement is attached.
- 2. In connection with that sale, Richard E. Mohan prepared and signed an Environmental Disclosure Document For Transfer Of Real Property on January 20, 1995, and delivered it to Theodore F. Elmore of the Indiana Department of Transportation. It was recorded in the Lake County Recorder's Office on May 25, 1995, as Document No. 95029700. It contained the following incorrect information, which is hereby corrected:
 - a. It referred to the address of the Property as 4705 Cleveland Street, Gary, Indiana, but the correct address is 4701 Cleveland Street, Gary, Indiana.
 - b. In paragraph II A (6) no mortgage or trust deed was part of the transaction ounty Recorder!
 - c. In paragraph II B (1) the Transferor consisted of both Richard E. Mohan and Marsha L. Mohan.
 - d. In paragraph III A 1, Richard E. Mohan answered "Yes" to the question, but the correct answer was "No." The transferor never conducted the operations described.
 - e. In paragraph III A 4 which states "Are there any of the following specific units (operating or closed) at the property that are used or were used by the transferor to manage hazardous wastes, hazardous substances or petroleum?", Richard E. Mohan answered "Yes" as to the Underground Storage Tank. In fact, any underground storage tank or tanks at the property were not then being used and had never been used by the transferor.
 - f. In paragraph III A 4 Richard E. Mohan answered "Yes" as to Wastewater Treatment Units. In fact, there not any wastewater treatment units at the property which were then being used or which had ever been used by the transferor.
 - g. In paragraph III B 1, the names of the previous owners are Raymond Litton and Jerry H. Litton.
 - h. The attached Site Plan shows four (4) underground storage tanks, but as stated in paragraph III A 12 Richard E. Mohan did not know the exact number.
- 3. Since the execution of the Environmental Disclosure Report described in paragraph 2 above, the transferor has obtained

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information indicating that the undersigned storage tanks at the property were taken out of operation before January 1, 1974, and therefore, no notice of the existence of such tanks to the Indiana Department of Environmental Management was or is required under 42 U.S.C 6991 a (a) or IC 13-23-1-2 (c) (8) (A). Since the property does not contain one (1) or more facilities that are subject to reporting under Section 312 of the federal Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986 (42 U.S.C. 11022), since the property is not listed on the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Information System (CERCLIS), and since no notice of the existence of tanks is required as above stated, the property is not "property" as that word is defined in IC 13-11-2-174, and in the opinion of the transferor no disclosure document is required to be delivered by the transferor to the transferee under the provisions of IC-25-3-2. Based on the cited statutory provisions it is also the opinion of the transferor that no disclosure document was required to be delivered by the transferor to the Indiana Department of Transportation in connection with the sale described in paragraph it tabove perowever, since that disclosure document contained erroneous information as noted in paragraph 2 above and was recorded, and since the transferee may be of a different opinion as to the obligation of the transferor to deliver a disclosure document to him, the transferor has prepared this Environmental Disclosure Document For Transfer Of Real Property for delivery to the transferee and subsequent recordation to correct the record and to satisfy the requirements of IC 13-25-3-2 in the event the transferor's opinion of its inapplicability is incorrect.


