WHEREAS, the City, the District and NINI entered into a certain Ground Lease and Asset Acquisition Agreement on or about October 3, 1994 providing for the acquisition of certain assets including the former East Chicago Municipal incinerator building, inventory, fixtures, improvements, utility connections, pipes and related and other equipment existing on the parcel of real estate described below; and

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> WHEREAS, said Agreement also provided for a Ground Lease for a parcel of land legal description of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A" ("Premises"); and

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WHEREAS, the Parties have reached agreement to the effect that said Ground Lease and Asset Acquisition Agreement should be terminated forthwith and that the assets acquired thereunder should be returned to the City and District, and that NINI, as prior owner of said building and equipment, and as Lessee under said Ground Lease shall entirely, completely and permanently release, discharge and relinquish all of its rights under said Agreement.

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THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED, by and between the Parties, in consideration for the mutual covenants, terms and conditions herein after set forth and intending themselves to be legally bound as follows:

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Lease Termination. The Ground Lease for the parcel of real estate legally described upon Exhibit "A" is hereby terminated, discharged and released. NINI, its affiliates and subsidiaries shall have no further interest. possessory or otherwise, whatsoever, in the premises from and after February 15, 1999.
