**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** by the court as follows:

1. Said final report and account of said is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.
2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining for distribution should be made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting to the decedent's heirs at law, and is hereby in all things approved.

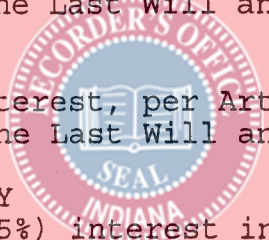
3. Said personal representatives are hereby authorized and directed to pay Kenneth M. Wilk the sum of \$ 10000 as and for his attorney fees and the sum of \$ 3000 to Michael G. Greaney and Dennis A. Greaney as personal representative fees in the administration of the within estate.

4. After payment of attorneys fees and personal representative fees, as set out above, said personal representatives are hereby directed to distribute and pay over the balance of the estate for distribution, as follows:

One-Sixth (1/6) interest, per Article V, Sub-Section A of the Last Will and Testament
- b. KATHLEEN A. GREANEY-KRAS  
One-Sixth (1/6) interest, per Article V, Sub-Section B of the Last Will and Testament
- c. MARGARET M. GREANEY  
One-Sixth (1/6) interest, per Article V, Sub-Section C of the Last Will and Testament
- d. DENNIS A. GREANEY  
One-Sixth (1/6) interest, per Article V, Sub-Section D of the Last Will and Testament
- e. MICHAEL G. GREANEY  
One-Sixth (1/6) interest, per Article V, Sub-Section E of the Last Will and Testament
- f. TERRENCE J. GREANEY  
Fifteen percent (15%) interest in the One-Sixth (1/6) interest, per Article V, Sub-Section F(i) of the Last Will and Testament
- g. ERIC M. GREANEY  
Fifty percent (50%) interest of the Eighty-Five percent (85%) interest remaining from the One-Sixth (1/6) interest of Terrence J. Greaney, per Article VI of the Last Will and Testament
- h. SAMANTHA GREANEY  
Fifty percent (50%) interest of the Eighty-Five percent (85%) interest remaining from the One-Sixth (1/6) interest of Terrence J. Greaney, per Article VI of the Last Will and Testament

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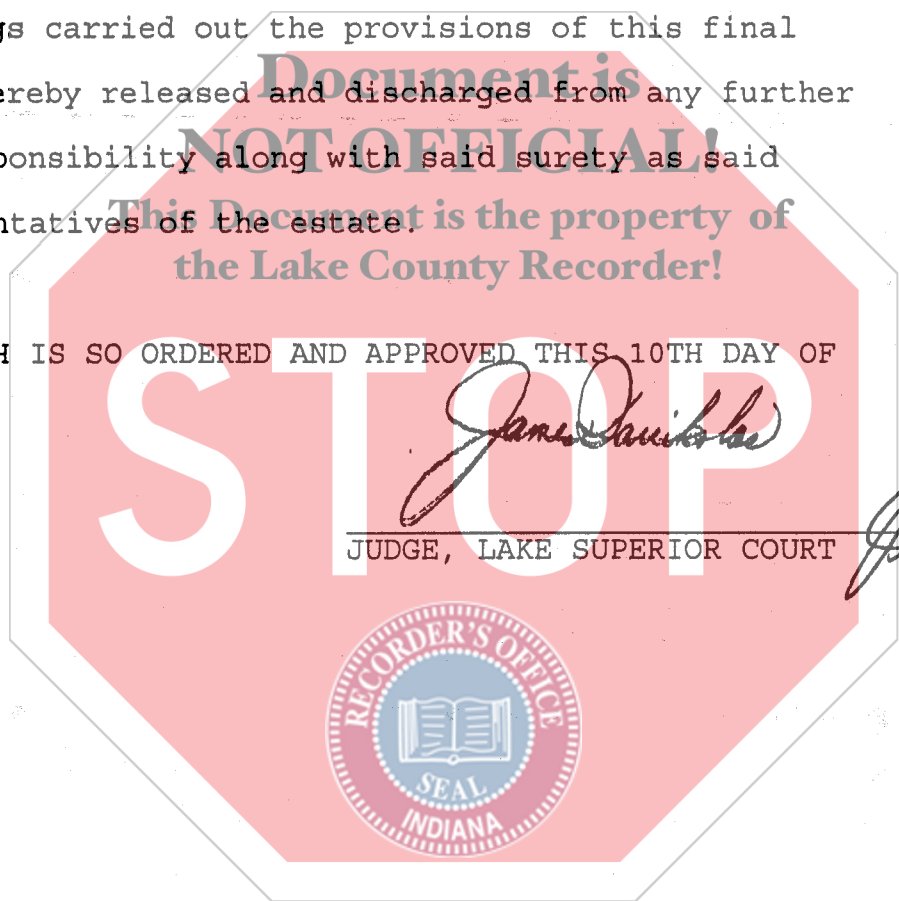
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5. Following the payment of attorneys fees and personal representative fees, and the distribution to the named heirs, any residual money in the estate is to be distributed equally amongst the named heirs set out in paragraph 4 above.

6. Said personal representatives are hereby directed to file a supplemental report showing that all terms of this order have been complied with and that said personal representatives have in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree and are hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility along with said surety as said personal representatives of the estate.
