This Power of Attorney revokes all previous powers issued in behalf of the attorney(s)-in-fact named above.

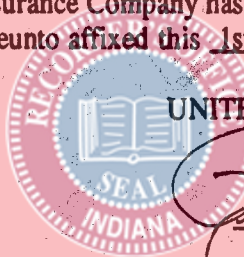

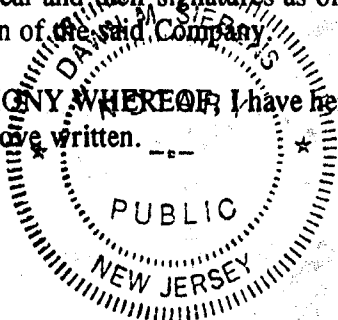

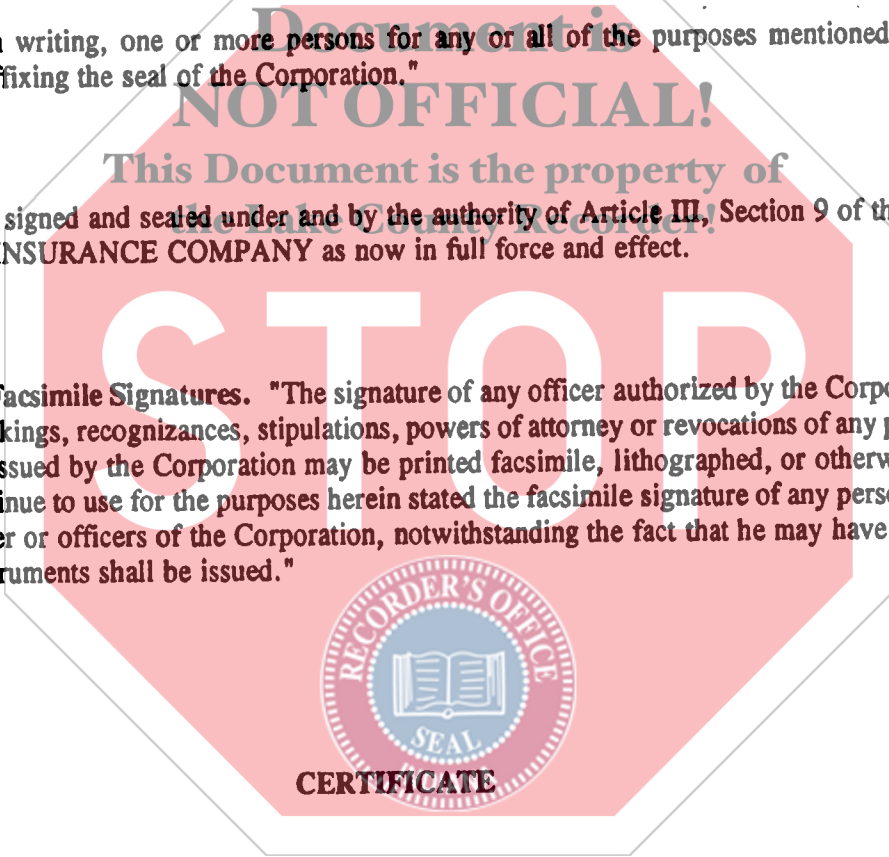
