DANIEL M. KRUPA, being first duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and says:

1. That Affiant's spouse, Jacqueline J. Krupa, died May 10, 2000 leaving a Will on March 26, 1991.
2. That they were duly and legally married at the time they acquired title as husband and wife to the following described real estate:

Parcel 1: A part of the South 1/2 of Section 27, Township 34 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd P.M., Lake County, Indiana, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the Easterly side of Out-Lot 40, Lake Shore Addition to Cedar Lake, Indiana (as said Subdivision appears of record in Plat Book 20 page 9), 12 1/2 feet Southerly from the Northeast corner of said Out-Lot 40; thence Easterly 70 feet parallel to the North line of said Out-Lot 40 extended; thence Northerly to the South line of "The Cedar Lake Conference Ground" extended; thence Westerly 70 feet on said South line of "The Cedar Lake Conference Grounds" extended; thence Southerly 66.45 feet to the place of beginning, except therefrom the Westerly 10 feet thereof, by parallel lines in Lake County, Indiana.

Parcel 2: Outlots 41, 42, and North 1/2 of Lot 40, Lake Shore Addition to Cedar Lake, as shown in Plat Book 20, page 9, in Lake County, Indiana.

3. That the marital relationship which existed between them at the time they acquired title to said real estate remained in effect and unbroken until the date of Jacqueline J. Krupa's death.
4. That all funeral expenses in connection with the death of said decedent have been paid in full.
