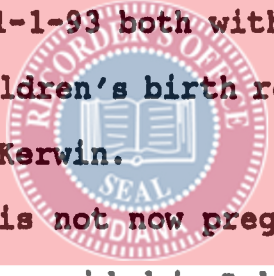

Comes now the parties in Court for hearing. Parties hereby
agree to a waiver of their rights to a final hearing.

Parties hereby agree to the following:

1. The parties were duly married on September 17, 1999.
2. Petitioner filed a Petition for Dissolution on September 3, 1999.
3. To the parties two children were born: Cortney, DOB: 21-92 and Brandon, DOB: 11-1-93 both with the last name of Garner. It is ordered that the children's birth records shall be changed to reflect the last name of Kerwin.
4. The petitioner is not now pregnant.
5. The parties both resided in Lake County at least 6 months prior to the filing of the divorce.
6. The marital relationship is irretrievably broken and the parties should be restored to being unmarried persons.
7. The petitioner shall be awarded custody of the children.
8. The respondent shall be entitled to visitation on every other Friday and Wednesday on the alternate week to correspond with his work schedule and at all other times as the parties agree.

9. The respondent shall pay \$100 per week for support of the children. The support is a deviation from the guidelines because he shall be responsible for the joint debt to Consumer Credit.

10. The petitioner shall be awarded the marital residence at 3756 Garfield, Gary, Indiana and be responsible for all debts and expenses therewith. The respondent shall Quit Claim his interest to petitioner within 14 days. If he fails to do so, the Court appoints Victoria McGuire to sign in his stead.

11. Petitioner shall be responsible for the debt to Aurora National Bank and hold the respondent harmless.

12. Petitioner shall be awarded the 1993 Grand Am and the respondent shall be awarded the 1983 Grand Prix.

13. Each party shall pay any debts in their own names and hold the other harmless.

14. The respondent & petitioner shall be awarded their separate pension or retirement or PERF.

15. The respondent shall pay \$700 toward the petitioner's attorney fees which shall be paid directly to Attorney Randy Godshalk within 75 days.
