this cause is now submitted to the Court for final hearing. The

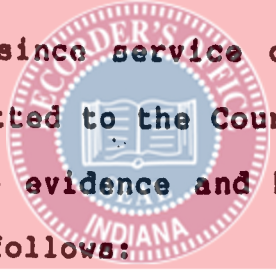
court, having heard the evidence and being duly advised in the

2. That the allegations contained in Petitioner's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage are true, and she is entitled to the relief requested therein.

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3. That the marriage of the parties is irretrievable broken and should be dissolved, restoring the parties to the status of single persons.

4. That the parties have entered into an oral property settlement, custody, support and visitation, agreement, which the Court finds was entered into fairly, is equitable and which the Court now approves.

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED
by the Court as follows:

1. That the marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved, and the parties are restored to the status of single persons.

2. That the oral property settlements, custody, support and visitation agreement entered into between the parties is hereby approved by the court as follows:

a. **PERSONAL PROPERTY:** Petitioner wife is awarded the sum of \$6,200.00 being held in escrow by the clerk of this court under cause number 45D03-9402-DR-00600.

b. **DEBTS:** Each party shall be responsible for his or her own respective debts.

c. REAL ESTATE: Petitioner is awarded all title and interest in the parties real estate located at 7578 Locust st. Gary. Respondent is awarded all right, title, and interest to all other real estate wherever located.

d. NAME CHANGE: Petitioner's maiden name of Wright is hereby restored. Petitioner shall hereafter be known as Beverly Wright.

e. ATTORNEY FEES: Attorney Patricia S. Beecher is awarded the sum of \$800.00 being held in escrow by the clerk of this court under cause number 45D03-9402-DR-00600.

f. RESTRAINING ORDER: The restraining order previously entered in this matter shall hereafter be made permanent.
