- B. Reservation of Power to Act and to Revoke. I reserve unto myself, however, the power to act on my own behalf and also to revoke or amend this Power of Attorney.
- C. Chapters of Statute Also Applicable. The following chapters of the Statute also apply to this Power of Attorney and acts performed under it: Definitions (IC 30-5-2), General Provisions (IC 30-5-3), Duties (IC 30-5-6), Reliance (IC 30-5-8), Liabilities (IC 30-5-9), and Termination (IC 30-5-10).
- D. Liability of Attorney in Fact. As permitted by IC 30-5-9-5, I, as principal, LED specifically provide that my attorney in fact is liable only if my attorney in fact acts in bad faith. OCT 25 2000
- E. Reliance on Power of Attorney. In addition to provisions of the Stateter Benjamin regarding reliance, any and all holding institutions at which the parallel of the hold an account or interest may rely on this Power of Attorney being in effect unless I shall have executed a proper instrument revoking or changing it and delivered such instrument, or caused it to be delivered to such person or entity.
