Commonly known as: 2438 Spencer St., Lake Station, Indiana.

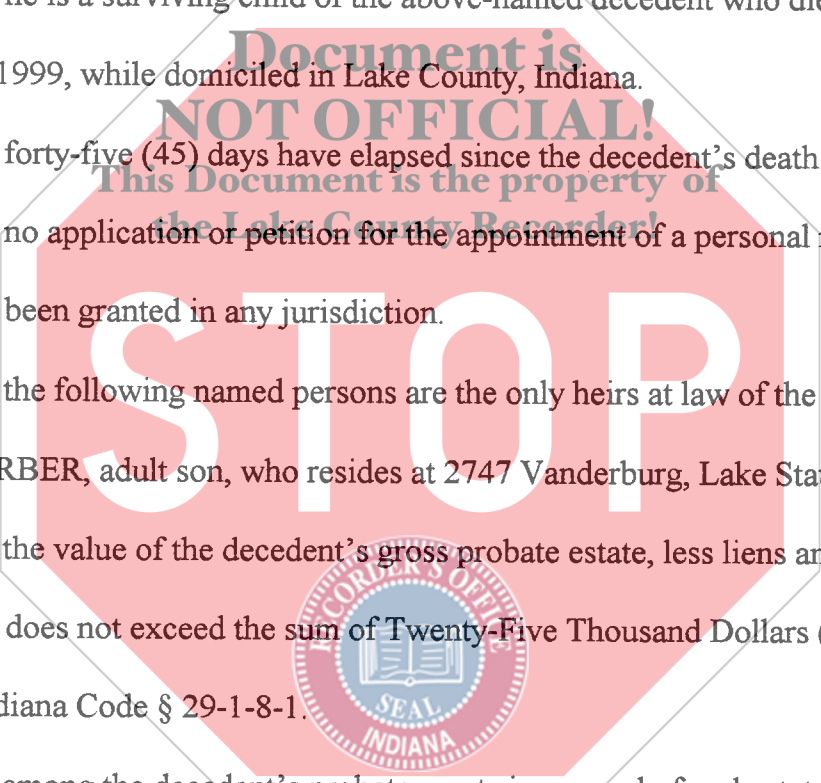
7. That, so far as is known to the affiant, there are no creditors of the estate.
