THIS MORTGAGE dated September 3, 2003, is made and executed between Robert L. Trimble, not personally but as Trustee on behalf of Trimble Living Trust, dated April 02, 2001, an Indiana Living Trust, whose address 1104 Highway 330, Griffith, IN 46319 (referred to below as "Grantor") and Bank One, N.A. with Columbus, Ohio as its main office, with a loan production office at Independence LPO, 7925 Taft Street, Merrillville, IN 46410 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages and warrants to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest, whether existing or hereafter acquired, in and to the following described real easements, rights of way, streets, roads, alleys and public places, privileges and appurtenances, public or private, now or hereafter used in connection with the Property; all rights to make divisions of the land that are exempt from the platting requirements of all applicable land division and/or platting acts, as amended from time to time; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation with the ownership, operation or maintenance of the Property; all insurance proceeds; all awards, including subleases, licenses and other agreements for the use and/or occupancy of the Property, oral or written, rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including, without limitation, all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters (the "Real Property") located in Lake County, State of Indiana:

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REVOLVING LINE OF CREDIT. Specifically, in addition to the amounts  $\boldsymbol{s}$ and without limitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit, obligations and advances to Borrower up to a maximum amount of \$10 with all the terms of the Note. Grantor hereby: (1) releases and waives any future claims against any Indemnified Person (as defined in the Indemnity provision in the MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS section below) for indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any Environmental Laws; and (2) agrees to indemnify and hold harmless each Indemnified Person against any and all obligations, actions, judgments, suits, claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, disbursements, costs and expenses, of any kind or nature, which any Indemnified Person may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from, any use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, refinement, transportation, disposal, release or any Hazardous Substances occurring during or prior to Grantor's ownership of the Property, whether or not the same was or should have been known to Grantor, (c) any investigatory or grantor or any occupant at the Property that is required by any Environmental Laws and (d) the contamination of the Property by any Hazardous Substances, by any means whatsoever (including, without limitation, any migration of any Hazardous Substances onto the Property, present or future).

The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indemnify, shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lien of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lender's or any Indemnified Person's acquisition of any interest in the Property, whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

**Nuisance, Waste.** Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), coal, clay, scoria, soil, gravel or rock products without Lender's prior written consent.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without Lender's prior written consent. As a condition to the removal of any Improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such Improvements with Improvements of at least equal value.

**Lender's Right to Enter.** Lender and Lender's agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Real Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property, including without limitation, the Americans With Disabilities Act. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

**Unexpired Insurance at Sale.** Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance with Existing Indebtedness. During the period in which any Existing Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such Existing Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on ioss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

LENDER'S EXPENDITURES. If any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interest in the Property or if Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage or any Related Documents, including but not limited to Grantor's failure to comply with any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or to discharge or pay when due any amounts Grantor is required to discharge or pay under this Mortgage or any Related Documents, Lender on Grantor's behalf may (but shall not be obligated to) take any action that Lender deems appropriate, including but not limited to discharging or paying all taxes, liens, security interests, encumbrances and other claims, at any time levied or placed on the Property and paying all costs for insuring, maintaining and preserving the Property All such Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender for such purposes will then bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses will become a part of the Indebtedness and, at Lender's option, will (A) be payable on demand, (B) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (1) the term of any applicable insurance policy, (2) the remaining term of the Note, or (3) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. The Property also will secure payment of these amounts. Such right shall be in addition to all other rights and remedies to which construed as curing any Event of Default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that Lender otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage:

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

No Other Liens. Grantor will not, without the prior written consent of Lender, create, place, or permit to be created or placed, or through any act or failure to act, acquiesce in the placing of, or allow to remain, any mortgage, voluntary or involuntary lien, whether statutory, constitutional or contractual (except for liens for advalorem taxes on the Real Property which are not delinquent), security interest, encumbrance or charge, against or covering the Property, or any part thereof, other than as permitted in this Mortgage, regardless of whether the same are expressly or otherwise subordinate to the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage.

**Survival of Representations and Warranties**. All representations, warranties, and agreements made by Grantor in this Mortgage shall survive the execution and delivery of this Mortgage, shall be continuing in nature, and shall remain in full force and effect until such time as Borrower's Indebtedness shall be paid in full.

**EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS.** The following provisions concerning Existing Indebtedness are a part of this Mortgage:

**Existing Lien.** The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be secondary and inferior to the lien securing payment of an existing obligation to Bank One, NA. The existing obligation has a current principal balance of approximately \$90,764.52 and is in the original principal amount of \$90,764.52.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to any limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns.
