THOMAS G. O'CONNOR, SR., being first duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and says:

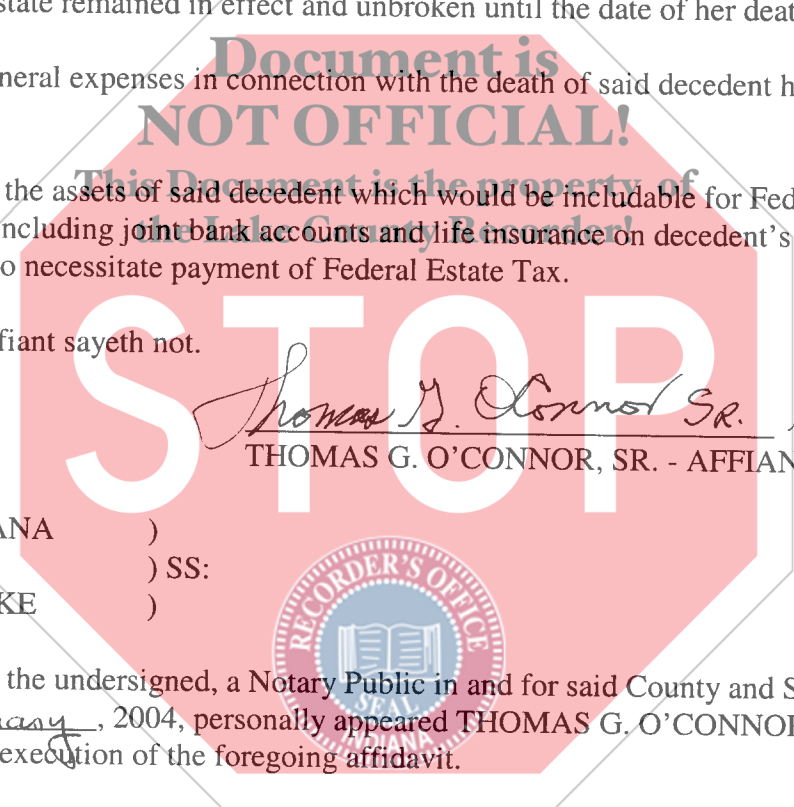
1. That Affiant's spouse, MARTHA R. O'CONNOR, died leaving a will on February 12, 2002, at Riley House in Munster, Indiana.
