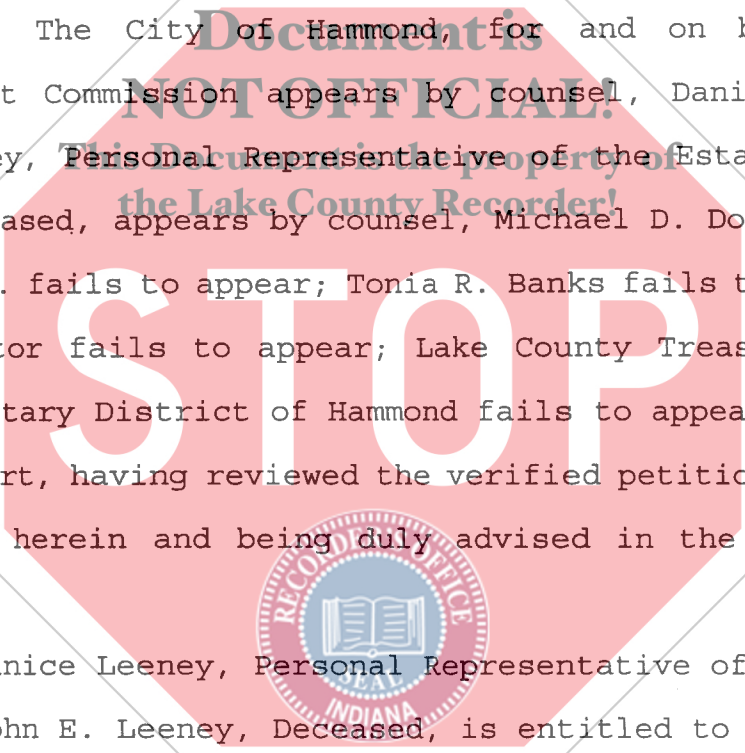


immediately paid over by the Clerk of the Court to Janice Leeney or her attorney, Michael D. Dobosz; and,

- (2) That the Hammond Redevelopment Commission is entitled to receive out of the monies deposited by the plaintiff on November 15, 1999, and is hereby awarded, Forty Three Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-One and 25/100 Dollars (\$43,491.25), plus all interest earned on said monies, which shall be immediately paid over by the Clerk of the Court to the Hammond Redevelopment Commission who shall then tender all such monies to the Lake County Board of Commissioners.
