KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, S.L. Feuquay & Co., Inc., P.O. Box 2233, Terre Haute, IN 47802 hereinafter referred to as the Principal, and Merchants Bonding Company, 2100 Fleur Drive, Des Moines, IA 50321, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Iowa and authorized to do business in the State of Indiana, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the Board of Lake County Commissioners, All Cities, Towns and Municipalities of Lake County, Indiana, 2293 N. Main Street, Crown Point, IN 46307, hereinafter referred to as Obligee, in the sum of Five Thousand and No/100ths Dollars (\$5,000.00) lawful money of the United States of America, to the payment of which sum, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our executors, administrators, successors and assigns, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That whereas, the Principal has made application for a license or permit to the Obligee for the purpose of, or to exercise the vocation of architecturally Patching Concrete.

NOW, THEREFORE, If the Principal shall faithfully comply with all ordinances, rules and regulations which have been or may hereafter be in force concerning said License or Permit, and shall save and keep harmless the Obligee from all loss or damage which it may sustain or for which it may become liable on account of the issuance of said license or permit to the Principal, then this obligation shall be void; otherwise, to remain in full force and effect.

THIS BOND WILL EXPIRE May 3, 2005 but may be continued by continuation certificate signed by Principal and Surety. The surety may at any time terminate its liability by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the Obligee, and the Surety shall not be liable for any default after such thirty day notice period, except for defaults occurring prior thereto.

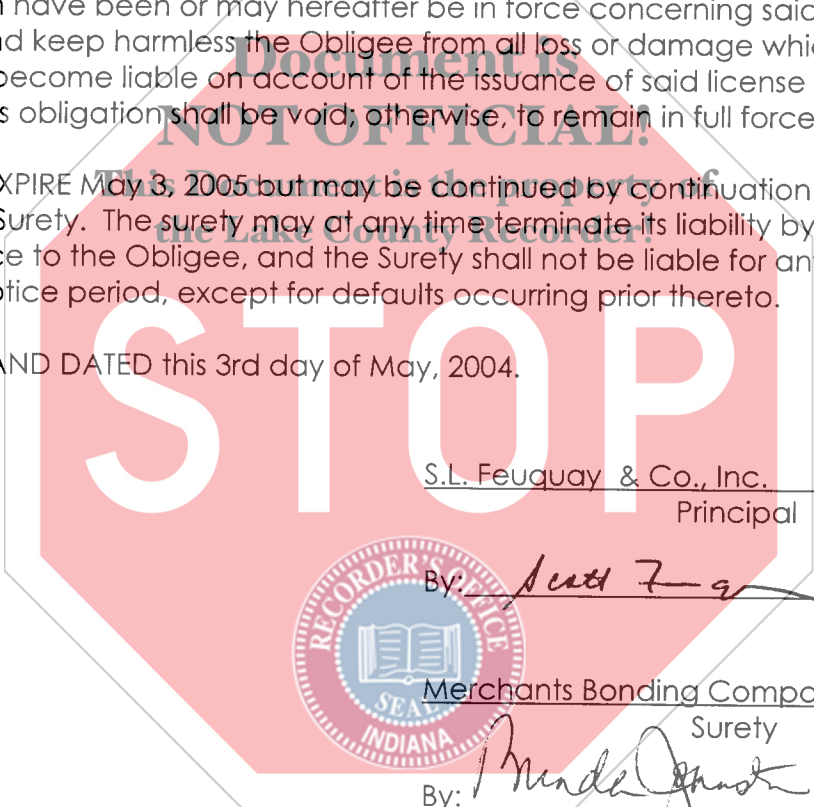

POWER OF ATTORNEY

THREE MILLION (\$3,000,000.00) DOLLARS

and to bind the MERCHANTS BONDING COMPANY (MUTUAL) thereby as fully and to the same extent as if such bond or undertaking was signed by the duly authorized officers of the MERCHANTS BONDING COMPANY (MUTUAL), and all the acts of said Attorney-in-Fact, pursuant to the authority herein given, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

This Power-of-Attorney is made and executed pursuant to and by authority of the following Amended Substituted and Restated By-Laws adopted by the Board of Directors of the MERCHANTS BONDING COMPANY (MUTUAL) on November 16, 2002.

ARTICLE II, SECTION 8 - The Chairman of the Board or President or any Vice President or Secretary shall have power and authority to appoint Attorneys-in-Fact, and to authorize them to execute on behalf of the Company, and attach the Seal of the Company thereto, bonds and undertakings, recognizances, contracts of indemnity and other writings obligatory in the nature thereof.

ARTICLE II, SECTION 9 - The signature of any authorized officer and the Seal of the Company may be affixed by facsimile to any Power of Attorney or Certification thereof authorizing the execution and delivery of any bond, undertaking, recognizance, or other suretyship obligations of the Company, and such signature and seal when so used shall have the same force and effect as though manually fixed.

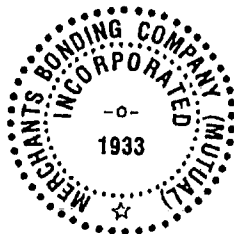
