Cause submitted, witnesses sworn, evidence heard and concluded and the MAGISTRATE being duly advised now finds and RECOMMENDS as follows:

- 1. More than 60 days have elapsed since this action was filed.
- 2. The Petitioner has been a continuous and bona fide resident of Porter County and the State of Indiana for more than six months preceding the filing of this action.
- The Respondent was served with notice by certified mail and this Court has jurisdiction over the parties of this action.
- 4. The parties were married on 14th of December, 1986 in Illinois and were separated on 14th of February, 2001.
- 5. Four children were born to the parties of this marriage. Three children, GLADYS ONTIVEROS, born 05-12-1980, MARIA C. ONTEVERO, born 05-15-1983 and GEORGE ONTIVEROS, born 08-08-1985 were born before the marriage and are the biological children of Jorge Miramontes. Gladys Ontiveros and Maria C. Ontivaros are emancipated. Two children are still dependant on their parents whose names, dates of birth and addresses are as follows:

George Ontivaros, dob 08-08-1985, 701 McCord #5, Valparaiso, Indiana Bertha Miramontes, dob 06-06-1993, 701 McCord #5, Valparaiso, Indiana

- 6. The Petitioner is not now pregnant.
- 7. The parties acquired a house in Hammond with the legal description of: The West 49 feet of Lot 63, Block 2, East Lawn Addition to the City of Hammond as shown in Plat Book 2, page 75, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, located at 1106 Truman Street, Hammond, Indiana 46320, which should be awarded to the Petitioner.
- 8. The personal property acquired by the parties was divided prior to the final hearing.
 - 9. Neither party acquired pension rights in prior or present employment.
- 10. Each party should be ordered to pay debts incurred in their individual names and to hold the other harmless thereon.
 - 11. The marriage of the parties is irretrievably broken and should be dissolved. IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:
- 1. The marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved and they are returned to the state of unmarried persons.
 - 2. Petitioner is given custody of the minor children of the marriage.
 - 3. Respondent, a resident of Florida, is awarded visitation as follows:
 - a. During time off school for the winter break in even-numbered years and not the spring break;
 - b. During time off school for the spring break in odd-numbered years and not the winter break;
 - c. Six weeks during the summer. Respondent will give the Petitioner at least 30 days notice of the dates he wishes to exercise visitation during the summer.
- 4. Respondent, whose date of birth is 04-18-1962 and whose Social Security number is 313-84-6612, shall pay \$104.00 per week for child support through the Office of the Porter County Support Clerk each Friday beginning March 26, 2004. Currently there is no pattern of visitation. Shared Parenting Credit will be determined when a pattern of visitation is established.
- 5. Respondent and Petitioner shall be entitled to alternate the claim of the parties minor children as dependents for purposes of federal and/or state income tax provided that Respondent is current in payment of support at the end of each year. The Respondent and Petitioner shall sign any federal and/or state forms necessary and proper to effectuate this

provision of the order. Respondent shall be entitled to claim the minor children in odd-numbered years, starting with 2003, and the Petitioner shall be able to claim the minor children in evennumbered years thereafter.

- 6. Each party shall provide medical, dental, optical and pharmaceutical insurance for the minor children when available as part of his/her employment.
- Petitioner shall be responsible for the first \$324.48 of all uninsured medical, dental, optical and pharmaceutical expenses of the minor children per year. This amount represents six percent of the total child support obligation per year. The balance of uninsured medical shall be paid as follows: 24% by Petitioner; 76% by Respondent.
 - 8. Each party is awarded ownership of personal property presently possessed.
- 9. Each party is ordered to pay debts incurred in their individual names and hold the other harmless.
- 10. Petitioner, Rosa Miramontes, is awarded all right, title, interest and ownership in the marital home in Hammond, Indiana, and Respondent, Jorge Miramontes, is divested of any right, title, interest and ownership in the marital residence, with the legal description: The West 49 feet of Lot 63, Block 2, East Lawn Addition to the City of Hammond as shown in Plat Book 2, page 75, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, commonly known as 1106 Truman Street, Hammond, Indiana 46320.

This order is a conveyance of title pursuant to Rule 70 of the Indiana Rules of Trial Procedure. No other documents are necessary to divest the Respondent, Jorge Miramontes, of ownership interests and to vest all title interest in the Petitioner, Rosa Miramontes.
