Count V: We, the Jury, find the Defendant, DAVID CHEAIRS, JR., not guilty /s/ Walter Hullinger, Foreman

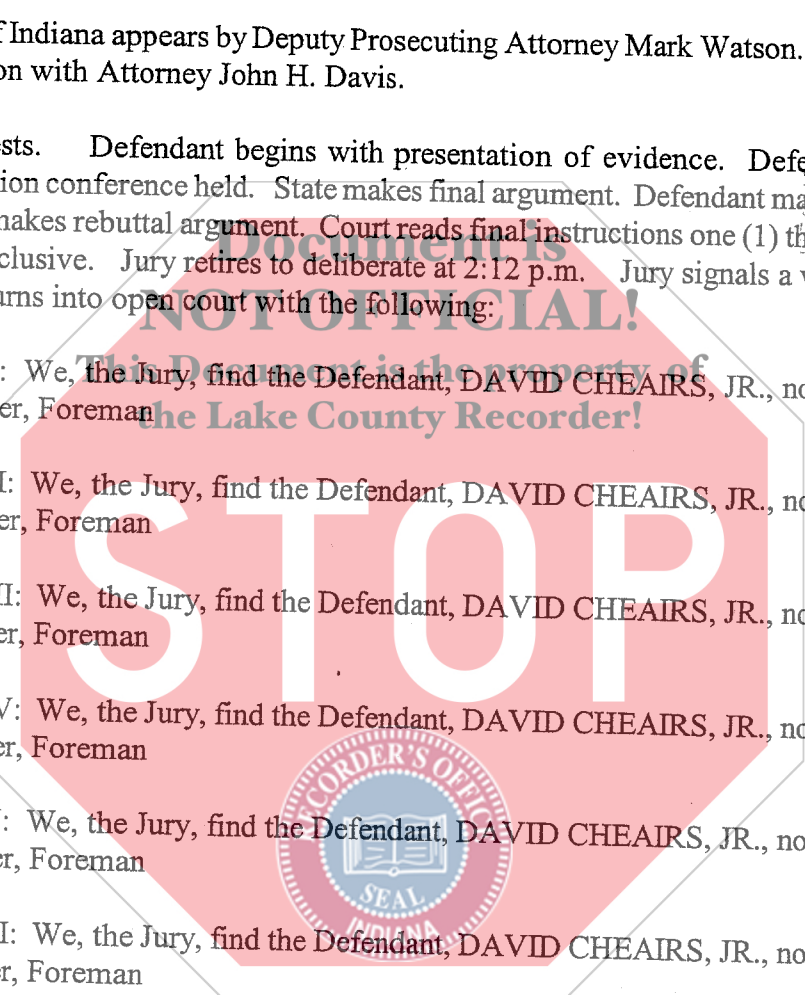
Count VI: We, the Jury, find the Defendant, DAVID CHEAIRS, JR., not guilty /s/ Walter Hullinger, Foreman
