ORDER

The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Nicholas Padilla. The defendant appears in person and by Attorney Charles Graddick. Jane Renfrow reporting. Defendant having pled guilty to Count I-Dealing in Cocaine, a Class B felony, pursuant to the plea agreement, this matter was continued to this date for the acceptance of plea and formal sentencing. The court is in receipt of and has had an opportunity to review the presentence report and said report is made available to the parties. Arguments are heard and the court being duly advised now accepts the defendant's plea, finds him to be guilty of Count I-Dealing in Cocaine, a Class B felony, and imposes a term of six (6) years imprisonment. The court now suspends two (2) years of said sentence, orders the defendant to serve four (4) years in the Department of Correction, and places him on probation for a period of two (2) years thereafter. The defendant is given credit for 20 days pretrial confinement time. The defendant is ordered committed to the Department of Correction for placement in an appropriate medium security facility. Conditions of probation are as follows: defendant is to refrain from the use of alcohol and/or drugs and not frequent places where they are dispensed; be subjected to periodic drug testing by the probation department; and is to comply with all other terms and conditions as set out by the probation department. The defendant is ordered to pay court costs in the amount of \$125.00 and an initial probation user's fee of \$25.00 and \$15.00 monthly thereafter. The real estate bond is ordered released. The State of Indiana files a motion to dismiss Counts II, III, IV, V, VI and VII, pursuant to the plea agreement, which is granted. This cause is disposed. The clerk is directed to prepare an abstract of judgment and to notify the sheriff. The defendant is remanded to the custody of the Lake County Sheriff for execution of the judgment of the court.
