This cause came on for hearing on August 30, 1985, upon the Final Account, Petition to settle and allow account and for authority to distribute estate filed by R. BRUCE WILSON, administrator with will annexed of the Estate of MARTHA HELEN WILSON, deceased, and no written objections thereto having been filed, which account and petitions are in the words and figures following, to-wit: (H.I.)

And the Court being duly advised in the premises now finds that:

- 1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.
- 2. MARTHA HELEN WILSON died testate, a resident of Porter County, Indiana, on September 6, 1984, and her Last Will and Testament dated June 17, 1953, was duly admitted to probate before this Court on November 8, 1984, and that this Court appointed R. BRUCE WILSON as Administrator with will annexed of said decedent on November 8, 1984, that the appropriate Letters were issued November 8, 1984, and since that date he has continued to serve in such capacity.
- The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that said Administrator has accounted for all the assets in this estate coming into his hands.
- 4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither decedent nor her Administrator were employers of labor within the meaning of that term used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.
