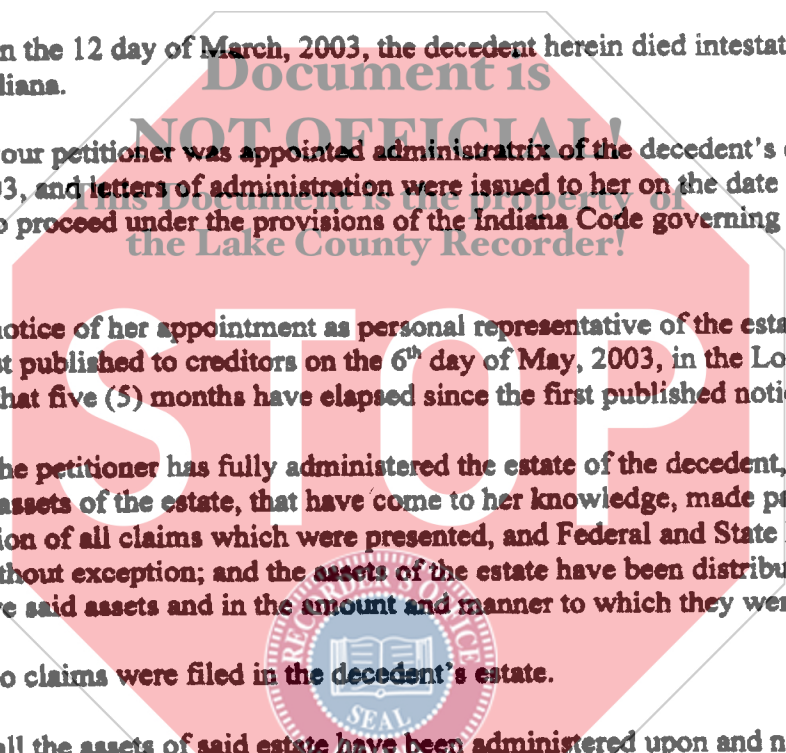

**ADMINISTRATOR'S VERIFIED CLOSING STATEMENT  
TO CLOSE ESTATE UPON COMPLETION OF ADMINISTRATION**

Comes now Nancy J. Houchin, as administratrix, of estate of Anne J. Glennon, deceased, who having been duly sworn upon her oath alleges as follows:

1. That on the 12 day of March, 2003, the decedent herein died intestate, domiciled in Lake County, Indiana.
2. That your petitioner was appointed administratrix of the decedent's estate on the 23 day of April, 2003, and letters of administration were issued to her on the date and said petitioner was authorized to proceed under the provisions of the Indiana Code governing unsupervised estates.
3. That notice of her appointment as personal representative of the estate of Anne J. Glennon was first published to creditors on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2003, in the Lowell Tribune newspaper, and that five (5) months have elapsed since the first published notice to creditors.
4. That the petitioner has fully administered the estate of the decedent, in that she has collected all the assets of the estate, that have come to her knowledge, made payment, settlement or other disposition of all claims which were presented, and Federal and State Income Taxes of the deceased, without exception; and the assets of the estate have been distributed to the persons entitled to receive said assets and in the amount and manner to which they were entitled.
5. That no claims were filed in the decedent's estate.
6. That all the assets of said estate have been administered upon and no reason exists why this estate cannot be closed at this time. That said petitioner has forwarded a copy of her accounting which is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A", and made a part of this closing statement to all heirs and distributees and their respective consents to the closing statement filed by the petitioner herein acquiescing to the facts set forth is attached.
7. That the decedent died owning a fee simple interest in the following parcel of real

estate located in Lake County, Indiana, of which no sale or other disposition was made during the period of administration. Said real estate more specifically being described as follows:

Lot 22 in Boulevard Estates 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition to the Town of Highland as shown in Plat Book 36 page 89 in Lake County, Indiana.

That title to said real estate vested in the decedent's heirs at law according to I.C. 29-1-2-1, and title in the real estate is now vested in Nancy J. Houchin 1/3 undivided interest, Martin J. Glennon 1/3 undivided interest, and Kathleen A. Baxter 1/3 undivided interest.

8. That is no action, objections, or proceedings are brought against the personal representative herein, within three (3) months from the date of the filing of this closing statement, that said petitioner should be released from any further liability with regard to the disbursement of the assets of the estate of Anne J. Glennon, which said petitioner collected and distributed pursuant to her accounting attached hereto.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner herein, Nancy J. Houchin, as administratrix of the estate of Anne J. Glennon, hereby requests that said closing statement be placed on file with the Court and that if no action or objections be brought within three (3) months, said closing statement be approved by the Court and the personal representative discharged from any further responsibility and her appointment terminated.
