The Indiana legislature has adopted the statute set out below:

## IC 36-2-7.5-5

Affirmation of individual preparing document for recording; form

Sec. 5(a) An individual preparing a document for recording shall affirm, under the penalties for perjury, that the individual has:

- (1) reviewed the entire document before submitting the document for recording for the purpose of identifying and, to the extent permitted by law, redacting all Social Security numbers; and
- (2) taken reasonable care to redact each Social Security number in the document. This Document is the property of
- (b) An individual shall make the affirmation required under subsection (a) on a form prescribed by the state board of accounts.

As you can see, the preparer of the document must sign an affirmation or declaration on a form prescribed by the state board of accounts which states that the individual preparing the document has reviewed the entire document and has, to the extent permitted by law, redacted all Social Security numbers and has taken reasonable care to redact each Social Security number in the document. The statute is to take effect January 1, 2006.

A copy of the Declaration prescribed by the state board of accounts is attached to this memo.

Section IC 36-2-7.5-6 provides that the recorder may not record the document without this affirmation/declaration which must be completed and executed as described in Section 5.

In the rush of closing you may expect that parties to the transaction will ask you to close the transaction and "wait" for the affirmation/declaration to be delivered to you post-closing so the documents can be recorded. You are urged not to accept such requests but rather insist that the affirmation/declaration be presented to you along with the documents at time of closing.

- Otherwise you will be faced with many documents which cannot be recorded although the transactions have otherwise been closed and all of the problems attendant upon such circumstances.
- There have been efforts made to amend these statutes. If anything develops along these lines, we will advise you. In the meantime, please be guided by the directives contained here.
