The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Judith Massa. 04-19-05 defendant appears in person and with Attorney Mark Gruenhagen. Cause submitted for acceptance of plea and sentencing. The Court now accepts plea agreement and finds the defendant guilty of Possession of Cocaine, a Class C Felony.

> Having considered the written pre-sentence investigation report, the Court sentences the defendant to four (4) years in the Indiana Department of Correction, two (2) years suspended. Defendant to serve the remaining two (2) years in the Lake County Jail, and two years on formal probation. The defendant is to receive credit for 227 days spent in confinement as a result of this charge, plus 227 days of good time credit as provided by law, for a total of 454 days credit.

> The defendant waives the reading of the rules of probation in open court. The Court imposes probation fees as determined and assessed by the Probation Department.

> As a special condition of probation, the defendant is ordered to obtain his GED. As a further condition of probation, the Court imposes a drug abuser fee pursuant to I.C. 33-19-6-9, in the amount of \$200.00.

Court costs are imposed. Judgment liens are entered for court costs.

The defendant is advised of Criminal Rule #11.

The clerk is directed to notify the Lake County Sheriff and the Probation Department. Cause disposed. (Diane C. Iannessi reporting.)
