KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That St. John Plumbing Service, Incorporated
located at (address/city/state/zip) P.O. Box 365 Schererville, IN 46375 as
Principal; (hereinafter called Principal) and **The Cincinnati Insurance Company**, located in Fairfield, Ohio, as **Surety**
(hereinafter called Surety) are held and firmly bound unto The Board of Commissioners of the Cnty. of Lake, St. of IN, &
any Cities, Towns & Municipalities in Lake Cnty, IN as **Obligee** (hereinafter called Obligee) in the full and just sum of
Ten Thousand and Zero Cents----- (\$10,000.00)
to be paid to said Obligee, its successors and assigns, for the payment thereof well and truly to be made, we jointly and
severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns firmly by these presents.

The condition of the above obligation are such that
WHEREAS the Principal is an applicant for a Plumbing Contractor license and

WHEREAS, the said Principal will conform in all respects to the ordinances and building codes of the Obligee while
performing Plumbing Contractor work.

WHEREAS the effective date of this bond is July 21st 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the license shall be issued to the Principal who shall conform to the ordinances and codes,
including all amendments thereto, of the Obligee, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise, the same shall remain in
full force and effect until:

- DEFINITE TERM** ending July 21st 2007 unless renewed by
Continuation Certificate.
- CONTINUOUS** until cancelled by Surety.

It is hereby agreed and understood:

- (1) Regardless of the number of years this bond shall remain in force and the number of annual premiums paid
thereafter, the aggregate liability of the Surety hereunder is limited to the penal sum of this bond and any payment
or payments made shall reduce the amount of the bond to the extent of such payment or payments.
- (2) That the surety company reserves the right to cancel this bond by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the
obligee and on the effective date of such thirty (30) day cancellation notice, the surety is discharged and relieved
of any liability, it being understood and agreed, however, that the said principal and said surety will be liable for
any loss accruing up to the effective date of said thirty (30) day cancellation notice, in no event, however, in
excess of the penalty of the bond.

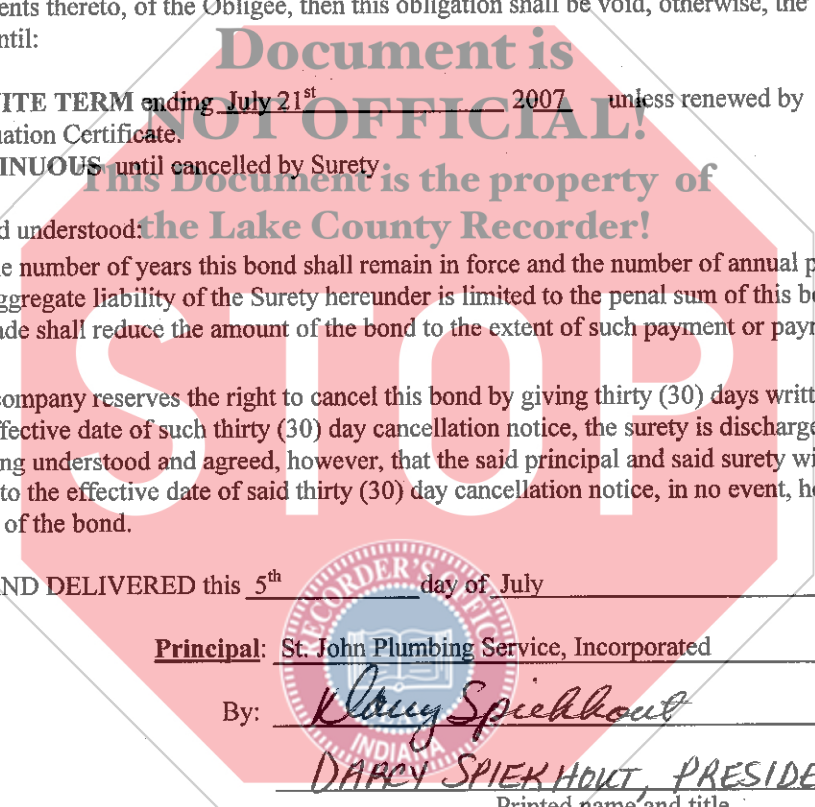

POWER OF ATTORNEY

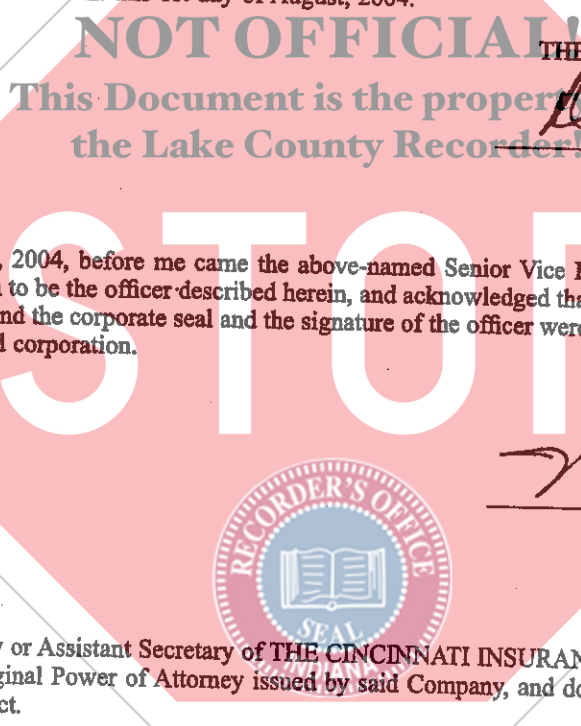

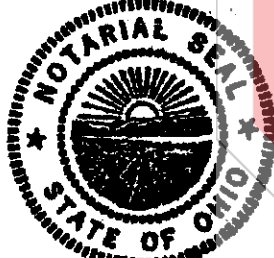
