

## AFFIDAVIT OF REVOCATION OF ASSUMED BUSINESS NAME

On March 5, 1981 Lake County Trust Company, not personally, but solely in its capacity as Trustee of Trust No. 2687 dated April 1, 1978 executed an <u>Assumed Name Certificate</u> stating that it would conduct and transact business under the name of **LAKE BUSINESS CENTER**. The Certificate was recorded in the Recorder's Office in Lake County, IN. on or about March 13, 1981 as Document No. 621091 and was further lodged with the Indiana Secretary of State's office.

Trust No. 2687 closed in 1987 and Lake County Trust Company ceased acting as Trustee. The Assumed Name Certificate was not valid after that time.

This affidavit is being recorded to ensure that the public records reflect that Lake County Trust Company, personally and corporately, never assumed any business name and further, that Lake County Trust Company, not personally, but solely in its capacity as Trustee of Trust No. 2687 dated April 1, 1978 ceased to assume the business name of LAKE BUSINES CENTER in 1987.
